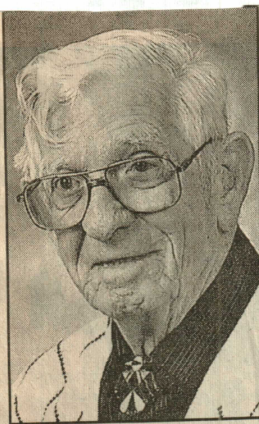


BROWN, James Edward 8 Jan 1924 - 6 Sep 2007
