DEATH OF DR. DUNHAM.

One of Trenton's Best Known Physicians
Passes Away—Sketch of His Life.

Dr. Charles H. Dunham, of South Warren street, died at his home this morning at 9:45 o'clock. The funeral will be from his late residence on Saturday afternoon at 1 o'clock. The interment will be at Mercer Cemetery.

Dr. Charles H. Dunham was born in Middlesex county on March 24, 1839. His ancestors on his father's side came from England in 1681. Rev. Edmund Dunham came and settled in Middlesex county. Here he established the Seventh Day Baptist Church. On his mother's side Dr. Dunham was descended from Pontius Delare Stelle, a Frenchman, whose name appears on the roster of Trenton Lodge, No. 5, F. & A. M., having been a Mason in 1788.

Dr. Dunham came to Trenton in 1853. He graduated from the University of Pennsylvania in 1864, and became an assistant surgeon in the army. He was assigned to Harewood Hospital at Washington, D. C., now the National Soldiers' Home. He was there about ten months. Later he returned to Trenton again and formed a partnership with Isaac D. James under the name of James & Dunham. This partnership lasted until 1874, since which time Dr. Dunham practiced alone with his office and residence at No. 121 South Warren street.

Dr. Dunham was on the active staff of St. Francis Hospital for seventeen years as physician and surgeon, but retired from active service a few years ago on account of ill health. He has always been a Republican and has served as county physician and school superintendent.

On November 5th, 1867, Dr. Dunham married Miss Anna L., daughter of the late ex-Sheriff Amos Sickel. Mrs. Dunham died in 1874. The doctor belonged to the Masonic fraternity, being a member of Ashlar Lodge, No. 76, 3 x 3 Chapter and Palestine Commandery, No. 4, K. T.

The staff of St. Francis Hospital held a meeting at eleven o'clock this morning and decided to attend the funeral in a body. A committee to draft suitable resolutions was appointed and consists of Drs. Mackenzie and Wetherill.
