Marcus Davis McQueen, born January 23, 1980 born and raised in Groveton, brought so much joy into his parents life. Delores and Mark McQueen.

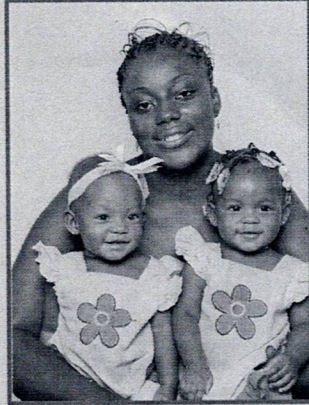
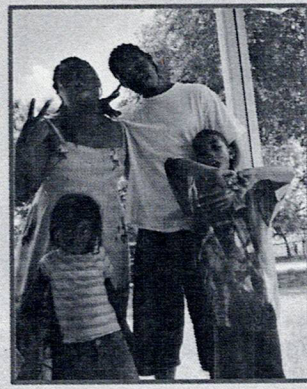
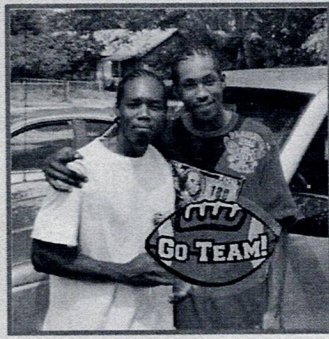
He attended Groveton Elementary and High School.

For I'm walking in the pathway of glory and Jesus is my guide.

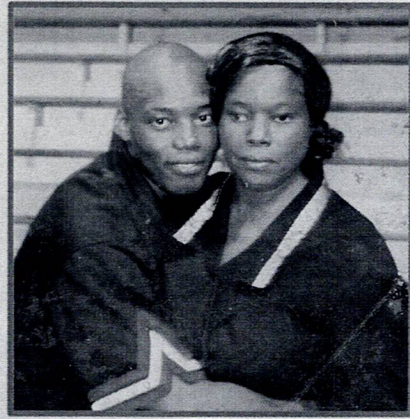
So I say to you may family, mourn for me no more.
