

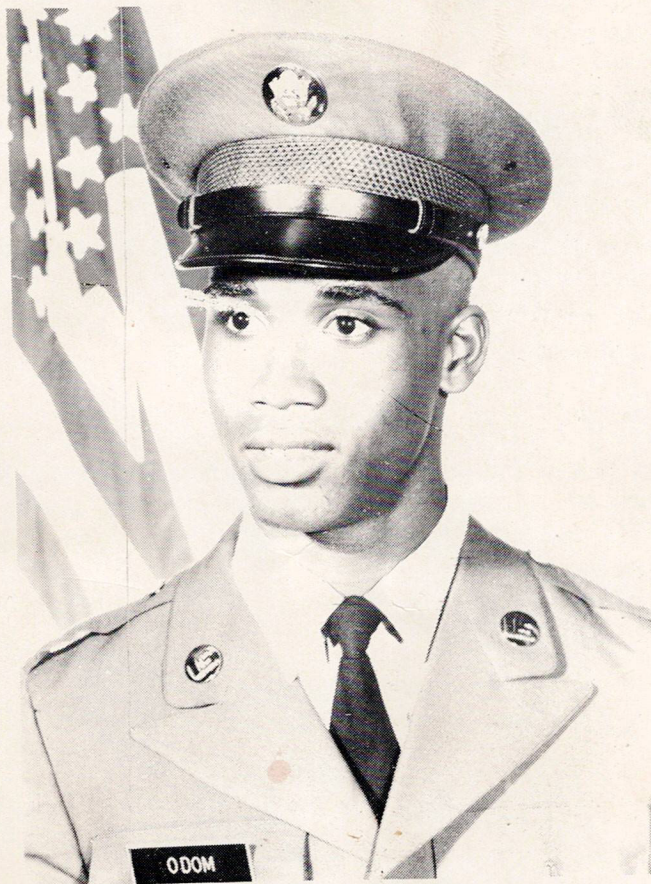

Mr. Clayton Odom, Sr., son of Mr. Leon Ducas, Sr. was born December 2, 1954 in Jasper, Texas.

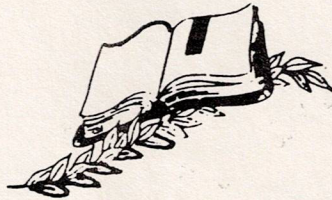
