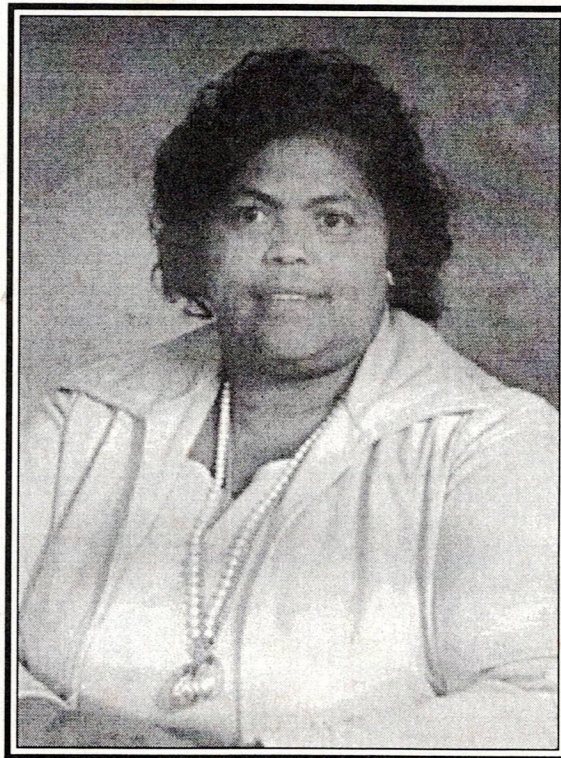

I finished early.*

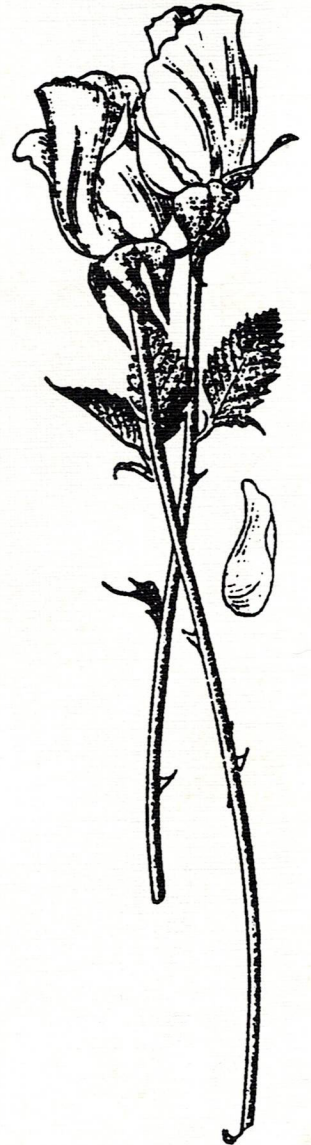
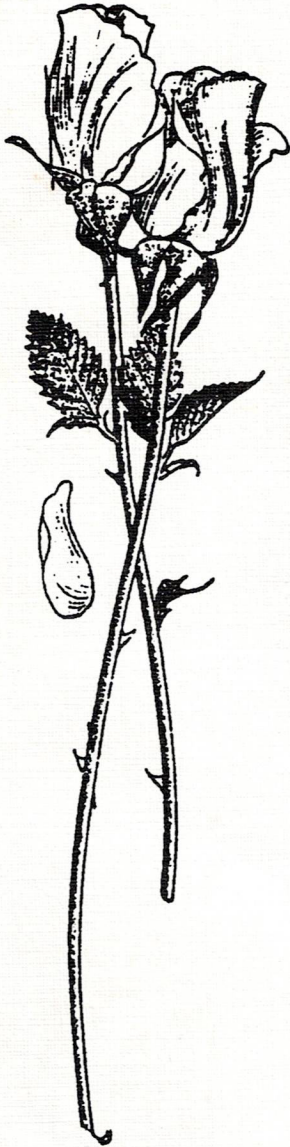
*I started on time,

I finished early.*

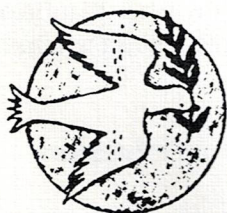
*By the measures of man's mind,

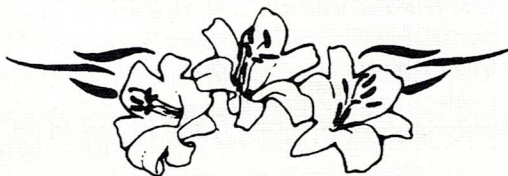
