Marriage: To Curly Jones, who preceded her in death.

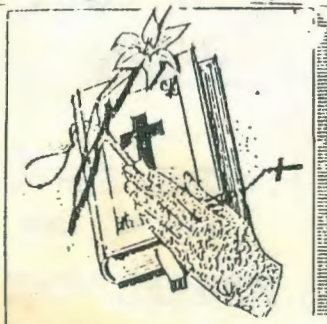
Livelihood: Worked as a restuarant cook for many years.
