Biographical Sketch

Mrs. Nancy Carter Stewart, the fifth child of Jefferson Calhoun and Sarah Randolph Carter, was born in Nigton, Texas. There she grew to young womanhood and completed her public school education. At a very early age, she accepted Christ and became an active member of Ligon Chapel Methodist Church.

She entered Wiley College to begin her undergraduate studies and was later graduated from Texas Southern University with a Bachelor Of Arts Degree.

In 1928, she was married to Dr. Claude Milton Stewart of Lufkin. Here, she joined the Long Chapel Christian Methodist Episcopal Church and was engaged in a variety of Church Activities. Dr. Stewart's death occurred in 1944.

Her teaching career continued over a span of forty years. In 1972, she retired from a profession which she dearly loved and to which she brought a dedication and commitment to excellence that enriched the lives of those whom she taught.

On February 5th, she became ill and was admitted to Memorial Medical Center, where death came on March 16, 1987.

Survivors are two sisters, Mrs. Jessie L. Davis of Los Angeles, California, and Mrs. Maggie C. McCoy of Lufkin; a stepson, James Edward Stewart, Houston, Texas; seven nieces, Mrs. Editha Anderson, Mrs. Mary A. Robinson and Mrs. Johnnie Kelly of Seattle, Washington; Mrs. Clarice Coleman, Lufkin; Miss Marie Davis and Mrs. Theresa G. McDonald of Los Angeles, California and Mrs. Alice P.
