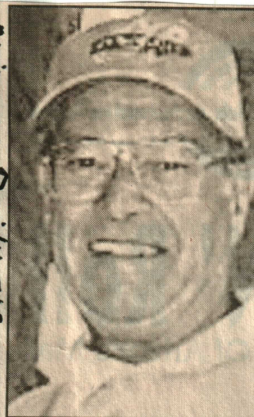


ARMELIN, James P. died 5 Sep 2007
