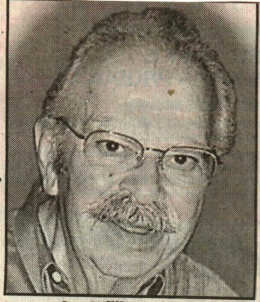


CHONIS, Gus William d. 15 Feb 2011 obit
