

THE OLD FRIENDS CEMETERY OF TOLEDO

In submitting the following burial records for the Old Friends Cemetery of Toledo, Mrs. White stated that until she made these copies from the one existing book, there was only one copy. This cemetery is in Chase County, Toledo Township in Kansas. Mrs. White further states that Toledo is not on the map any more, but it can be located by going one mile to the east of Saffordville (which is only a sign) on U. S. 50. Go north on the Lake Kahola road one mile, turn east on a graveled road and drive about one-fourth of a mile. The cemetery is on the north side of the road. The monuments are in need of repair and some need to be reset. The cemetery is mowed regularly whenever Hilltop Cemetery is mowed. The first burial here was in 1862 and the last burial was in 1920.

The graves are laid out in 8 tiers, running north and south. The west tier is the same as tier # 1.

Copied from the Bible Records of Ezekiel Dye

This Bible was owned by Marian Rice Rhodes of Wichita, Kansas. Ezekiel Dye was her great-grandfather who served in the Civil War. His diary was written up by Helen Lee in the Midwest Genealogical Register, Vol. XI, #1 - June 1976. The Bible was given to Helen Lee by Marian Rhodes in May, 1976.

Ezekiel Dye was born September 11, 1839. Jennie B. Townsend was born May 20, 1835 and they were married on the 26th of March, 1872. Three children were born; Henrietta S. Dye - 28 May, 1874. Mable Augusta Dye 31 August, 1874 and Edgar Clarence (Clarence) Dye 13 October, 1880.

Jennie B. Dye died June 19, 1929 - Ezekiel Dye died January 13, 1944
