

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## REPORT OF DEPARTMENT CHAPLIN.

*Comrades of the Department of Kansas:*

This is the second report that it has been my privilege to make to your honorable body, and it is with gratitude to the post chaplains and to our assistant adjutant general, who have so persistently assisted in gathering these reports. We have a larger number of posts reporting, with fuller reports, both of the memorial services and of the honor rolls. Last year 100 posts reported; this year we have reports from 222 posts, and all the other reports show the same care and attention.

Again the roll of honor rises before us with its ravages of twelve months, reminding us that all paths led but to the grave, for while we decorated 20,200 resting places of our comrades, we added 1000 to their number. The posts reported 600 deaths. It is safe to estimate that 400 of those not members of posts have died. There are nearly 9000 members of the Grand Army of the Republic in the state, and about the same number not members, or in round numbers 18,000 in all, out of the 140,000 once living in this, the greatest soldier state in the Union. One thousand deaths is about six per cent; six out of every hundred. The death rate of Kansas is about one per cent. If it was the same as that of the Grand Army of the Republic it would be 108,000 instead of 18,000. So we get some idea of the swift passing of the heroes of the sixties.

Posts reporting, 240; 70 report no deaths; 170 report 600 deaths. That means all the posts of any considerable membership are decorated in mourning all the year round.

May courage, fortitude, fidelity and faith in the God of our fathers be ours to the end.
