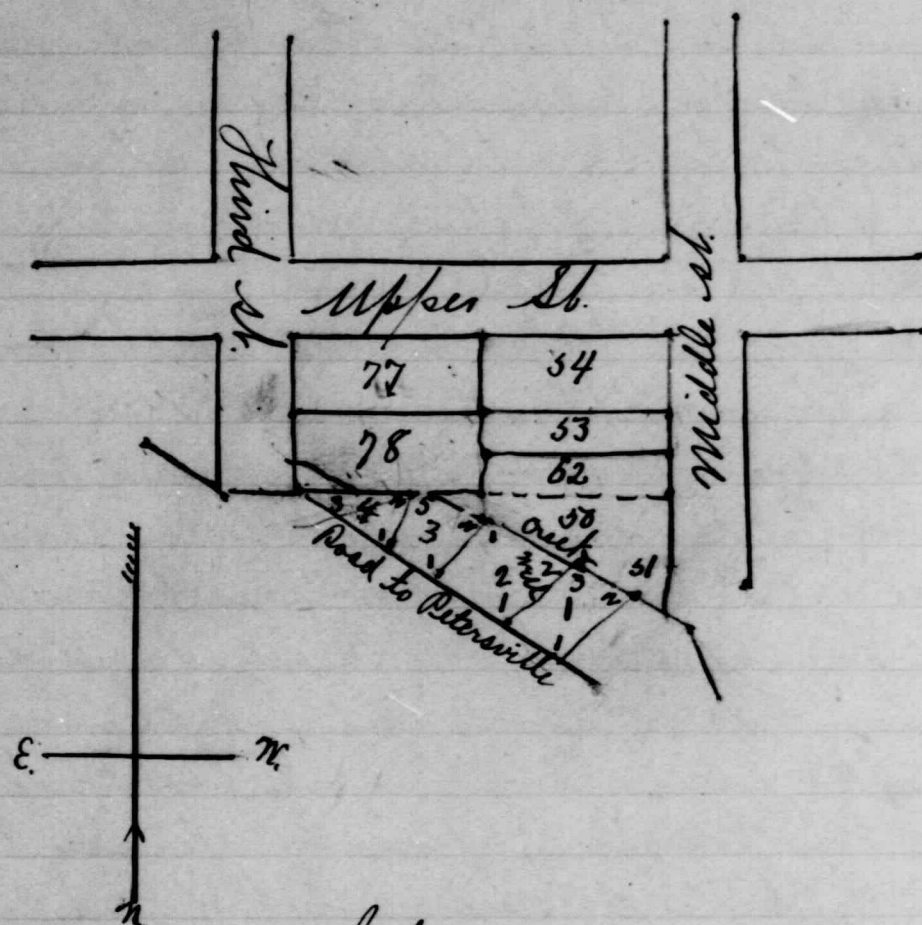
Survey, plat, &c. of lot No. 78, containing 40 sq. per. (adjoining the Bank
 lot No. 77 on North side) & bounding on third street & also the Northern
 half of lot No. 53 containing 20 sq. per. & likewise part of lots No. 52 &
 51 containing $37\frac{3}{4}$ sq. per. bounding on Middle street & bearing the orig-
 inal numbers on the old plat of the town of Brunswick, Maryland,
 as originally laid out.

Also a triangular strip of land, in said town lying between the
 small creek & the County road leading to Petersville & lying adjacent to the
 above mentioned lots now surveyed & laid off into 4 lots, numbered
 1-2-3 & 4 on plat now made. All of the aforesaid lots or parcels of land
 being the property or in the name of G. W. Benjamin & wife & R. E. Benja-
 min surveyed & laid out at the request of Messrs. G. W. Wachtel & Reno
 S. Harp assignees

Beginning for the survey of lot No. 78 on 3rd street & running on
 the dividing line of the bank lot with an allowance for variation, N.
 $77\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ N. 10 per. thence ² N. $12\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 4 per. thence ³ S. $77\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 10 per. thence to
 beginning, containing 40 sq. per. of land, the bearings of lot No. 53 are
 same at lot No. 78, running back from Middle street 10 per. with a front-
 age on said street of 2 per. being only half lot, containing 20 sq. per.

Beginning for the survey of lot No. 52 & part of 51 now combined into
 one (as lot No. 51 was originally a very small piece, lying next to the
 small creek) on the N.W. corner of lot 53 on Middle street & run-
 ning S. $77\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 10 per. thence ² N. $12\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 1.2 per. to middle of creek, thence
 up creek ³ N. $42\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 9 per. thence ⁴ S. $60\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 2.4 per. 5 thence to begin-
 ning, containing $37\frac{3}{4}$ sq. per. of land.

Courses + distances of Lot No. 1

Beginning at a stone planted in the West side of the county road leading to Petersville about $2\frac{1}{2}$ feet from the corner of an ice house & running parallel with said ice house 1. S. $59\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 6 per. to the middle of creek, thence 2. S. $42\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 3. 2 per. 3. N. $55\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 5 per. thence to beginning, containing $15\frac{3}{4}$ sgr. perches.

Lot No. 2

Beginning at the East corner of lot No. 1 & running with present magnetic bearings viz:- 1. S. $55\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 5 per. 2. S. 42° E. 5 per. 3. N. $50\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 4 per. thence to beginning, containing 21 sgr. per.

Lot No. 3

Beginning at East corner of lot No. 2, viz 1. S. $50\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 4 per. 2. S. $42\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 4 per. 3. N. 50° E. 3.92 per. thence by straight line to beginning, containing $14\frac{1}{2}$ sgr. per.

Lot No. 4

Beginning at corner of lot No. 3 as follows:- 1. S. $50\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 4 per. 2. S. $42\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. $6\frac{1}{2}$ per. 3. N. 59° W. $5\frac{1}{4}$ per. containing $10\frac{1}{5}$ square per of land.
