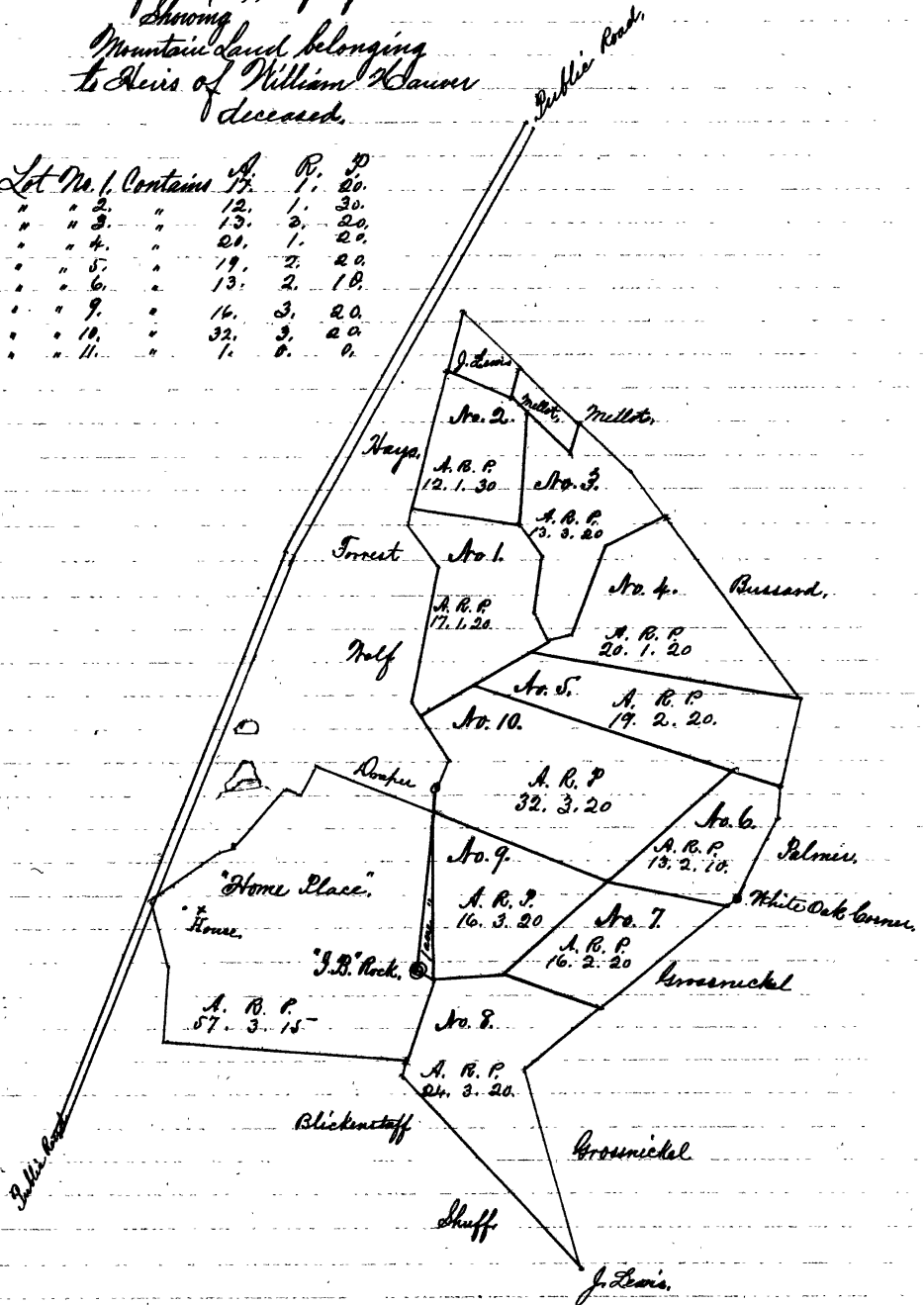

Lot No 1.

Beginning at a Stone at the end of the 3rd line of a
deed from Benjamin Shuff and wife to William Hauser &
of which this is a part, said deed being recorded in Liber
D. C. No. 5 Folio 6814e, one of the Land Records of Frederick
County, and running with the outline thereof, N. 15° E. 55½ ps. N. 40°
W. 20 ps. N. 16° E. 5½ ps. S. 79° E. 42 ps. S. 30° E. 44 ps. S. 11° W. 20
ps. S. 30° E. 12 ps. S. 60° W. 58 ps. E. intersect said third line
of aforesaid deed; thence with it N. 33½° W. 8 ps. to place of
beginning and containing 17 acres, 1 R. and 20 Perches
of Land more or less.

Lot No 2.

Beginning at the end of 5½ ps. on the 6th line of said
deed, from Shuff and wife to William Hauser, and running
thence N. 16° E. 5½ ps. S. 62° E. 26 ps. S. 43° E. 7½ ps. S. 4° E. 46½
ps. thence with the 4th line of lot No. 1 reversed, N. 79° W. 42 ps. to the
beginning, containing 12 acres 1 R. 30 ps. of land more or less.

Lot No. 3.

Beginning at the end of the 7th of said deed from Benjamin
and wife to William Hauser, it being also the end of the
17th line of the whole tract called the Range about the three
Miserable Tracts, and running thence with the 14th line thereof,
S. 36° E. 21 ps. S. 61° W. 25½ ps. S. 23° W. 33¼ ps. S. 67° W. 10½ ps.
N. 30° W. 12 ps. N. 11° W. 20 ps. N. 30° W. 14 ps. N. 4° W. 46 ps.
S. 43° E. 23½ ps. N. 20° E. 1½ ps. to intersect said 7th line of the
aforesaid deed, and with it, S. 45½° E. 29 ps. to place of be-
ginning, containing 13 acres, 3 Rods, and 20 perches, of land
more less.

Lot No. 4.

Beginning at the end of the 8th line of said deed from
Benjamin Shuff and wife to William Hauser it being also the
end of the 18th line of the original tract called "The three mis-
erable Tracts" and running thence N. 77° W. 108 ps. to inter-
sect the 8th line of Lot No. 1, thence with said 8th line reversed
N. 60° E. 7¾ ps. thence with the 2nd, 3rd and 4th lines of lot
No 3, reversed N. 67° E. 10½ perches N. 23° - 33¼ ps. N. 61°
E. 25½ perches thence S. 36° E. 89 ps. to place of beginning, 20
acres, 1 R. and 20 perches of land more or less.

Lot No. 5.

Beginning at same place as Lot No. 4, and running with the 9th line of said deed, S 8° N. $30\frac{1}{2}$ pches, thence N 7° N. $126\frac{3}{4}$ ps. to intersect the 8th line of Lot No. 1. thence with said 8th line reversed, N. 60° E. $20\frac{1}{2}$ ps. to the end of the first line of Lot No. 4 and with it reversed S. 77° E. 108 ps. to place of beginning containing 19 acres, 2 Rods and 20 Pches of land more or less.

Lot No. 6.

Beginning at the end of the 9th line of said deed from Benj Shuff and wife, to William Hauser, it being also the end of the 19th line of the aforesaid original tract, The 'Miserable Mobbs' and running thence S. 29° N. 36 ps. S. 54° N. $3\frac{1}{2}$ ps. S. 72° N. 57 ps. S. 58° E. 68 ps. to intersect the 2nd line of Lot 5 and with said line of Lot No. 5 and with said line reversed S. 70° E. 20 ps. S. 131° N. $26\frac{1}{2}$ ps. to place of beginning containing 13 acres 2 Rods and 10 ps. of land more or less.

Lot No. 9.

Beginning at the end of the 15th line of said deed from Shuff and wife to William Hauser, it being also the end of the 59th line of the original tract called 'The Range about the three 'Miserable Mobbs' and running thence N. 63 ps. S. 69° E. 76 ps. S. 52° N. 54 ps. S. 81° N. $32\frac{1}{2}$ ps. to place of beginning containing 16 acres, 3 R. and 20 ps. of land more or less.

Lot No. 10

Beginning at the end of the first line of said Deed from Shuff and wife, to William Hauser, it being also the end of the 61st line of the whole original tract and running thence with the outline thereof two Courses viz: N. 33° E. 13 ps. S. 36° N. 20 ps. thence with the 8th line of Lot No. 1. reversed, N. 60° E. 25 ps. thence with the second line of Lot No. 5 reversed, S. 70° E. $106\frac{1}{4}$ ps. thence with the 4th line of Lot No. 6, reversed S. 52° N. 68 ps. thence with the second line of Lot No. 9 reversed, N. 69° N. 76 ps. to the end of $61\frac{1}{2}$ ps. on the aforesaid first line of said deed and with it: N. $6\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. $1\frac{1}{2}$ ps. to place of beginning containing 32 acres 3 R + 20 pches of land more or less.

Lot No. 11

This lot contains one acre of land, more or less and lies within the fence now standing enclosing the farm of Lydia Hauser.
