


Exhibit B is on the words & figures following viz -

 At the Beginning

Running with the blue shaded line
 Numbers from 1 to 22 Inclusive -
 By a Scale of 50/4.

Beginning at a Stone now planted, on the South edge of the Balti-
 more & Ohio Rail Road and on the North side of Bush Creek, it being
 on the dividing line, between Henry Stapp Duffs Land and the Land now
 being described, and running thence by and with said dividing line S.
 $43\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E $38\frac{6}{10}$ ps to a Stone planted by a white Oak tree, still S $3\frac{1}{4}$ or $112\frac{1}{2}$
 ps to a Stone now planted at the end of the 2^d line of the part devised to Col
 John Montgomery by the aforesaid John Montgomery &c. then by & with
 said line reversed S 56° E $82\frac{1}{4}$ ps to a Stone planted, at the end of the 1st line
 of the part aforesaid it also being at the end of 17 $\frac{7}{10}$ ps, on the 5th line of 67 $\frac{25}{100}$ -
 deeded by Samuel Duvall to John Montgomery, then by, and with said
 5th line N $22\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ E $83\frac{3}{10}$ ps across the Resurvey on Balleys Good will, to a
 Stone planted and marked & near a chestnut tree, marked with 19 $\frac{1}{10}$ ps
 it also being the end of the 11th line of 139 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres deeded by John & M Elfen
 to John Montgomery, and running thence by and with the out lines of
 said Deed 4 Courses viz S $54\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ E $176\frac{5}{10}$ ps to a marked Red Oak tree N $2\frac{1}{2}$
 E 66 ps to a Stone planted & marked & still N $17\frac{7}{8}^{\circ}$ W 165 ps to a Stone now plan-
 ted between two marked Saplins standing on the South Side of Bush-
 Creek it also being at the end of the 23^d line of the whole Tract called -
 The Rights of Mann" and at the Beginning of the aforesaid Deed
 for 139 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^{ac} still N 65 or $22\frac{4}{10}$ ps to a Stake on the North Side of

Road, and by and with the north side of Bush Creek, following
