

Plat of the several Tracts of Land, called, as follows, viz Part of "Benjamin's Good Luck" Part of "Biggs Lot" (The "One Brother" per Patent, Parts of the Six Brothers, "Sharks Chance", "Maddles Delight", "Biggs Delight" parts vacancies. The yellow shaded lines from red A to Blue C, numbered, and from 1 to 2 shows the per Patent. The green shaded lines from blue C to D thence with a black dotted line to the beginning, also the green shaded lines from C to D thence with the yellow shaded lines to C, again, show the Courses of the Title papers exhibited,

The green and yellow shaded lines from B to L thence with the red drawn and shaded line to M thence to B. again shew the Widows part of the Six Brothers and numbered from 1 to 4 - The balance of the Six Brothers per Little papers exhibited are shewn from M to L and numbered from 1 to 9 thence by the red drawn and shaded line to the beginning - The red dotted lines from N and numbered from 1 to 7 shew. "Sparks, & Chance" - The Black dotted line from G to O thence with the green and yellow shade to P. thence with a black dotted line to G again, shew the unconveyed part of "Waddles Delight" and numbered from 1 to 14 - "Biggs, & Delight" is shewn from H and numbered from 1 to 9. First vacancy by 1 - 2^d by H. - June 17th 1824

Part of Benjamin, & Goods Luck is shewn by the Blue and green shaded lines from D to I. then by the Black dotted and yellow shaded lines to D. again, and numbered from 1 to 7 on the reverse.

Part of Driggs, & Lot is shewn from C to K and L by the Blue and green shaded lines, thence by the Black dotted and yellow shaded to C. again numbered from 1 to 4 the reverse
