

This Mortgage made this 14<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year  
 Eighteen hundred and Ninety three by us J. Graham Johnson  
 Esq & Eyna L. Kemp his wife all of Frederick  
 County in the State of Maryland witnesseth that whereas we  
 the said J. Graham Johnson, Eyna L. Kemp & Florence V.  
 Kemp his wife by our joint and several promissory note  
 bearing even date with this presents and payable one  
 year after date to Elwin Johnson on or before the sum  
 of Eighteen Thousand Dollars with interest from date at  
 the rate of six per Centum per Annun and payable  
 semi Annually stands indebted to the said Elwin Johnson  
 in the amount of money in said promissory note specified  
 and for the purpose of securing the payment of said  
 promissory note at maturity and all interest that may accrue  
 thereon we the said J. Graham Johnson, Eyna L. Kemp and
