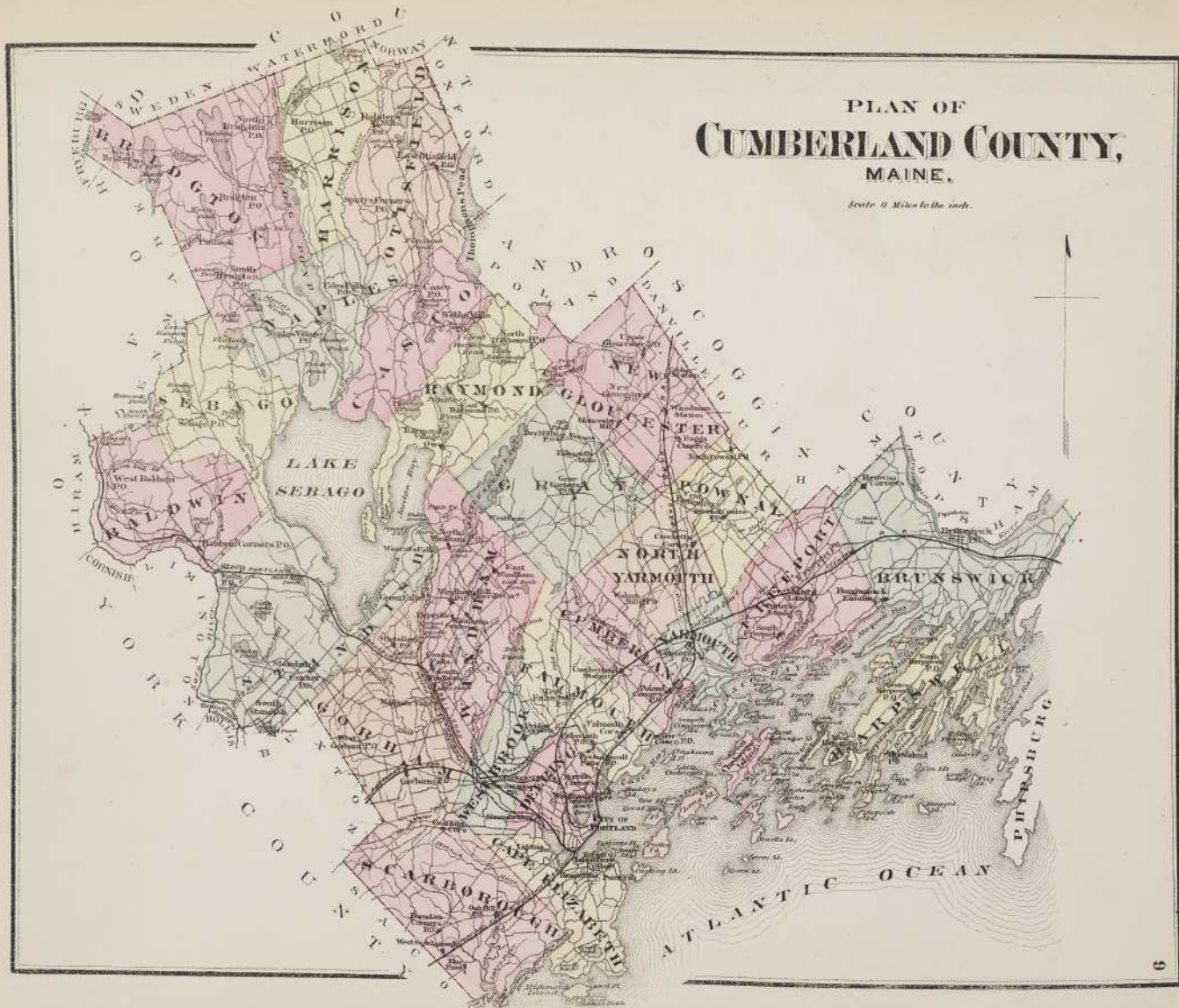


PLAN OF

TOWN OF DEERING

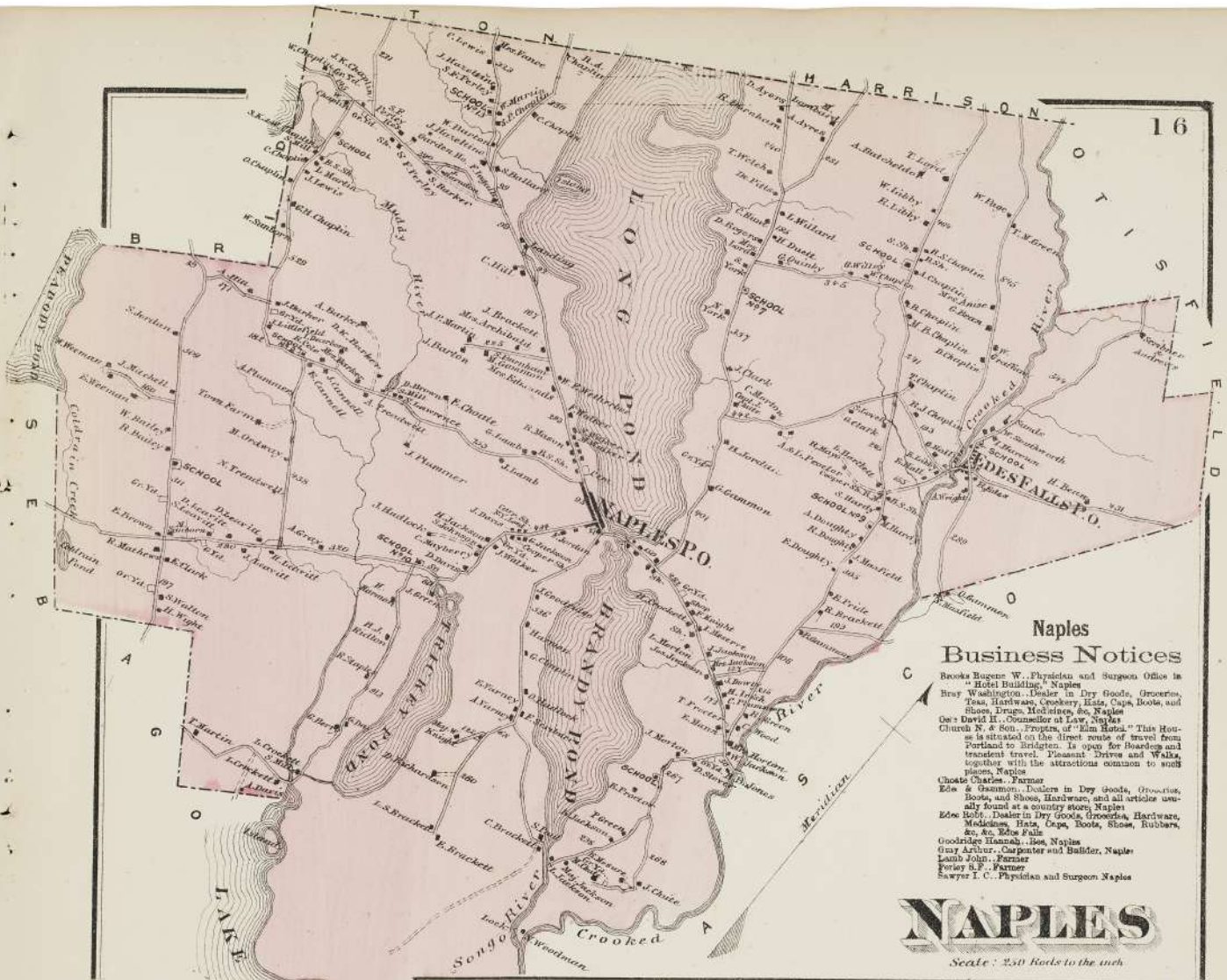

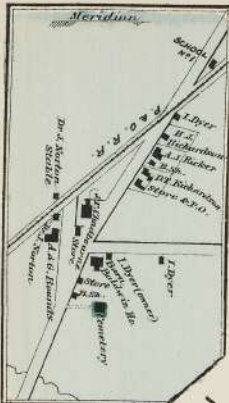

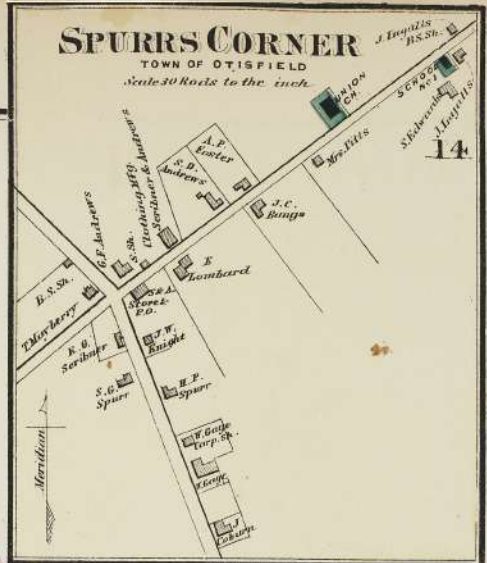
## WALNUT HILL

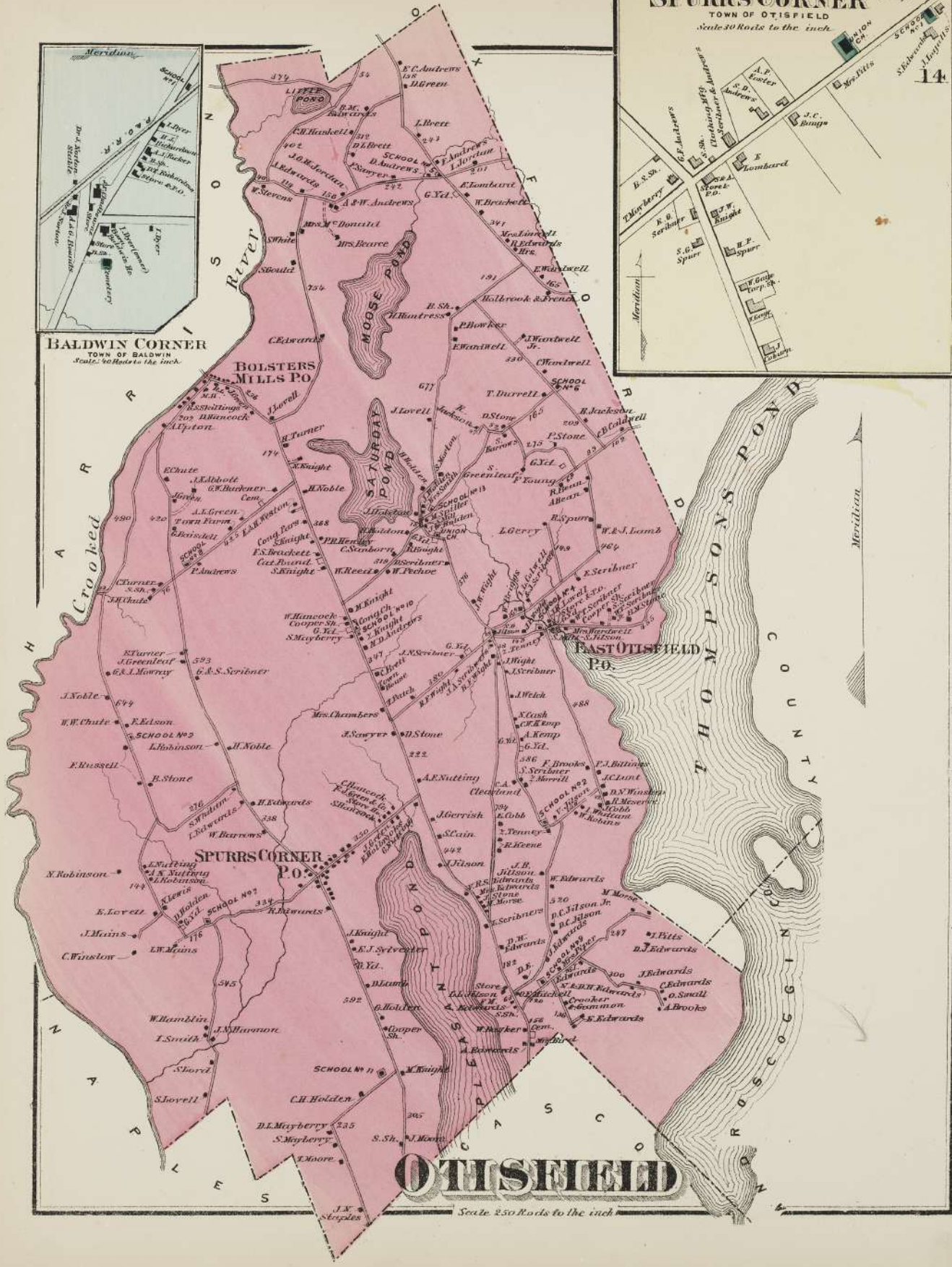


**BALDWIN CORNER**
