Archie Campbell - who I believe was my great grandfather. My maternal grandmother was Elizabeth Lenore Campbell Cooley (My maternal grandfather was Winfred J Cooley, who was of Grand Forks ND, I believe). The Campbell's were railroad people. They were a family of 10 children - I think Archie's wife was Mary Matilda McCarthy (sp?) Campbell. Do you have any record showing this family? My mother, Margaret June Cooley, was born to Elisabeth Lenore Campbell-Cooley and Winfred J Cooley in 1915 - I think in either Minto ND or Minot ND... more likely Minto because the family was also around the Grand Forks area at some point. The Campbell "clan" migrated (via British Columbia Canada) to Tacoma Washington in the early 20's I think. All of them came over time, with the exception of Alec Campbell - who became an executive with the railroad (the B.N.?) and moved down to Missouri.
