(b.1858 -d.1936) They lived in Canton Village, later known as Hensel, ND. Frank was born in Ireland, but they immigrated as a family with 4 or 5 children from Ontario, Canada. More were born in ND. Names of Children include Kate, Margaret, John, Mary, Veronica, Agnes, Sarah, Clara, Alice

and Frank. Many family members are buried in St. Patrick's cemetery in Crystal. Frank was a business owner in Hensel.

The other line I am searching is the Michael John CLEARY line. Michael b 10 May 1825 Ireland d. 22 Sep. 1901 Concrete, ND married Mary Ellen WOODS b. 31 Mar 1842 Ireland d. 5 May 1906 They immigrated from Limerick, Ireland in 1885, via Halifax, Nova Scotia, settling in the Concrete area. Re: Donald and Victoria (Husband) Thomson, who homesteaded in Pembina--they claimed Crystal as closest town, I believe. I sent for their death certificates, but ND records had neither of them--I am interested in knowing about their parents (both people).

Donald Thomson and Victoria Husband married in Niagara Falls, NY on 7/24/1862--from Guelph area of Ontario. Daughter Lillian born a year later in Guelph. Son Percy born 13 years later, in Christian County, Illinois. Then they moved to Pembina County--near Crystal, and stayed there until their deaths in 1912 and 1915, respectively. However, no

death certificates for them could be found according to ND Vital Statistics (just got their answer back). Would be interested in census info, family info, ANYTHING!

I got the pioneer women article on Agnes McLagan Husband, but it has nothing about this branch of the family (Victoria's brother William Nelson Husband was married to McLagan).
