Johannes Gudmundsson (Goodman) and Solveig Jonsdottir and their children: Joveig Johannesdottir, Oddny

Johannesdottir, Jonina Johannesdottir and Sigridur Johannesdottir left Akureyri, Iceland in 1874. They were on the SS

Patrick when it docked in Quebec on September 23, 1874. They went on to Markland Icelandic community in Nova

Scotia. There they had two more children; another daughter (Engema Johannesdottir) and a son. Their oldest Teenage

daughter died in Markland.

They left Markland and presumably went back to Winnepeg then on to the United States in the Dakota Territory. Their daughter Oddny Johannesdottir I believe became Maud Goodman and she married my Great Grandfather, Pascal Jarbo.

They had 7 children while living in Ardoch North Dakota.

Their daughter Joveig Johannesdottir I believe became Josie Goodman. She lived with the William P Andrus family while co-habitating with their son John Gordon Andrus. She and John had one son, Herbert F Andrus born in the Turtle River Township area in 1893. She married Thomas C Workman in 1901 and they had a son, Harold born about 1902-1903 in North Dakota. Evidently Mr. Workman died because Josie Goodman Workman moved with her sister and her family before 1909 to Blaine Washington.

Their other daughter Jonina Johannesdottir I believe became Maggie Goodman married to Joseph Lindall.

Johannes and Solveig are buried in Blaine Washington along with Josie and other Goodmans. Would you have any record of this family while they were in the Dakota Territory? I am looking for the proof that My Great Grandmother, Maud Jarbo, and her sisters were indid the children of Johannes Gudmundsson and Solveig Jonsdottir of Iceland.
