The Reverend Charles Green, an Anglican minister,
 compiled a list of tithables -- all persons by law in his
 charge -- within the area that is now Fairfax and
 Loudoun Counties. In 1757, Loudoun County was
 established from the western part of Fairfax. The
 Reverend Green's remarks often included religious
 affiliation or position within the community.
