

Harry Howell Succumbs Here

Harry F. Howell, Arizona pioneer and former cattle rancher, died yesterday in Good Samaritan Hospital after an illness of 14 months. He was 65 years old.

A native of Springer, Tex., Mr. Howell came to Arizona with his parents at the age of six. He resided at both Tonto, where he was a cattle rancher, and Payson, where for 23 years he was employed by the Gila county highway department.

During the past year he had been employed in Phoenix with the state highway department. His residence here was at 1907 West Jackson street.

Survivors are his wife, Mrs. Mamie M. Howell; a daughter, Mrs. James A. Patterson, Scottsdale, and a son, Jack K. Howell, Fort Ord, Calif.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m., tomorrow from the Memory Chapel of A. L. Moore and Sons, the Rev. S. O. Redacre and the Rev. John Warnock, officiating. Burial will be in Greenwood Memorial Park.
