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Preface

The town of Montpelier, Vermont, chartered in 1780 and occupying 23,040 acres was first settled in 1733 by Solomon Dodge and John Templeton. The first cemetery was the Center Burial Ground with two acres deeded to the town in 1794. The brush was cut. It was to be kept fenced and leased for grazing with small cattle-no hogs. Later several persons were buried and had gravestones, however, after it was not used for many years, the stones were put in the wall. At the time of the 1927 flood it is said the wall with remaining stones was used to repair the culvert at the nearby brook. In 1973 Barnabas Doty's stone was found in the New Hampshire Antiquarian Society, Hopkinton. It had been taken off the wall over one hundred years ago. It has been retrieved by descendants and brought back to East Montpelier,

In 1848 the town and city were divided by an act of the Legislature. The town with four fifths of the land area became East Montpelier. The city of Montpelier which became the capitol of the state in 1905 remains so to-day.

After the first edition of this research was published a box of vital record cards was found at the town clerk's office. The cards were the result of records compiled by the city clerk of Montpelier, Carlos Def. Bancroft in 1911 and contain records between 1794 and the late 1860's. The cemetery cards indicate he "read" the stones existing in the early 1900's. Some he 'read' are now no longer to be found but others we found he did not. Since all his records are on file in the Vital Records Dept. of the State the stones he did not find are not recorded there. In this second edition an asterick is used to denote information from the cards.

The oldest marked grave is Betsey, daughter of Enoch and Susannah Cate buried in 1794 in the Cate Cemetery.

In addition to information found on "the cards" this edition has the results of great effort made to read more of the poetry, thereby preserving that part of the history of the town which in many cases is fast wearing away.

Located on Town Road #46 on what was the site of the home of Caleb & Ruth (Davis) Bennett. They were members of the Quaker community in the town. The first Friends Meeting House and first house of worship in Washington County was a little further south of their home. The second Friends Meeting House was north of their home and on the other side of the road. The cards indicate not four but six of their children are buried here.

CATE CEMETERY

Located near Town Road 31 at the junction of Kingsbury Branch and the Kinooki River on the farm originally settled by Enoch Cate. The farm is now owned by Goddard College. In excellent condition and cared for by the Ladies of the Eastern Star as well as the town. The oldest stone, that of Betsey Cate who died 1794 is located here.

The Center Cemetery is located at the junction of State Highway #3 and the north side of Town Road #26. It is at the north end of what was once the Center of the town and the place the first settlers thought would be the important center of the town.

This was the first burial ground for the town of Montpelier. Two acres was deeded to the town in 1794 by Joseph Wing the proprietor of all of lot #40 in the First Division of the town. The brush was cut and according to early town records it was to be kept fenced and leased for grazing with small cattle-no hogs.

Long abandoned the tomb stones were put in the wall and at the time of the 1927 flood the wall was used to repair the culvert at the nearby brook.

In 1871 descendants of Capt. Barnabas Doty searched for and discovered his stone built into the wall. One of them, Silas Ketchum took the stone to the New Hampshire Antiquarian Society in Hopkinton, N.H. It was discovered there in 1973 and offered to the town.

Others were buried but since no records kept no one knows who. Lack of present day cemetery space and interest in the old cemeteries of this town will probably see this first burial ground used again and the return of Barnabas Doty's stone will give it a link with the past. In 1911, Mr. Bancroft, the author of the cemetery cards located in the East Montpelier Town Clerk's Office, called it the Doty Cemetery-a name possibly to call it by in the future.





P. 5321. Improvement of private burial grounds; duties of officers: When the use and care of a private burial ground has been abandoned and such ground becomes unsightly from any cause, or when headstones or monuments have been displaced, the selectmen or board of cemetery commissioners having charge of the public cemeteries in the town where such burial ground is located, on written request of three taxpayers of such town, shall forthwith cause a notice to be published for three weeks successively in some newspaper circulating therein, calling upon any person interested in such burial ground to cause the same to be put in proper condition within three months from the date of such notice. At the expiration of such time, if such demand is not complied with, the selectmen or board shall proceed then and thereafter as if such ground were a public burial place. Subchapter 2, Town Cemeteries. P 5361. Appropriations and regulations by towns. A town may vote sums of money necessary for purchasing, holding and keeping in repair suitable grounds and other conveniences for burying the dead. P 5362: Repair; expense: When lots or walks in a public burial ground become unsightly with weeds or by an unchecked growth of grass or from any other cause, or when headstones or monuments have become displaced or out of repair, the selectmen or cemetery commissioners shall cause such lots and walks to be cleared of weeds and grass, the headstones or monuments to be replaced or repaired or other disfigurements removed, and may draw orders on the town treasurer of a town for such purpose in any year shall not exceed \$500.00. P 5364: Fences; penalty: When the selectmen neglect to keep in repair the fence around a public burial ground, the town may be indicted for such neglect by the grand jury of the county, and fined not more than \$100.00 nor less than \$50.00. P 5366- Not liable until notified: A town shall not be indicted for not keeping in repair the fence around a burial ground, or be liable for damage done, unless the selectmen had notice in writing twenty days previous that the fence was out of repair.
