We believe that William Skinner, of Stow, Middlesex County, Mass. is our ancestor, but at this date we have not been able to prove this.

William Skinner was married in Stowe, Middlesex County, Mass. in 1722/23. He married again in 1730. He had 2 children by his first marriage and 4 children by his second.

His son Samuel was born in 1733 in Westford, Middlesex County, Mass. Samuel was married 3 times and had children all born in Putney twp. Windham county, Vermont according to town records. When the Skinner family moved from Massachusetts to Vermont the Hartwell family moved with them. Records show both families. The Skinners and the Hartwells have intermarried down through the years.

Samuel's son, Zachariah Skinner was married to Lidoy, in Vermont and travel with Zachariah to New York. In the 1810 Census we find and raised his family there. Census records show 5 sons and a daughter, in 1800. Zachariah died in 1815 in Haneoye, N.Y. My bible page has the date of 1815 on the death side, and seems to be Zachariah's. Zachariah and Asa Skinners names are in 1810. Census of Haneoye, Ontario Cty, N.Y. together.

The Bible page does prove that Asa Skinner is my Great Great Grandfather. Asa was born in Vermont, in 1783. His wife Anna was born in 1777. They traveled to New York where their family was born; in 1810 census they are in Haneoye, My Great Grandfather Daniel Johnson Skinner was born in 1814. Believe Angeline Skinner, youngest daughter of Asa born there also. After Zachariah's death the Asa Skinner and Hartwell families traveled down the Ohio River on a Flat boat and settled on Government land in Jennings County, Indiana. About the time of the Indian uprising.

Asa Skinner's children were married in Vernon, Indiana as was Asa. Anna passed away and he married Mrs. Ruth Boner.

In the 1840 Census Harley B. Skinner was listed, but his wife passed away after a daughter Anna was born and never heard from again. Grandfather Asa took care of her.

Angeline Skinner was married in 1834 and had a son Alphonso. She had passed away before 1867 or Asa would have listed her in his will instead of Alphonso.

Daniel Johnson Skinner, youngest son of Asa was married 1st. to Polly House, she passed away leaving 3 children, Daniel married again to Mrs. Nancy Spencer, who had two sons, David and Moses. Daniel and Nancy had three children and Nancy passed away. Daniel married a third time to Sarah Allen, they moved to Iowa where Asa joined the Civil War. Three children were born in Iowa. After he was released by the Army, the family traveled to Mexico, Mo. They were there in Feb. 1866. and in 1871 Daniel deeded the ground to Sarah and her heirs. Daniel and family came west to Colorado. They were here about 1872 or 73. His son Samuel was married in 1874 to Meliassa Melvina Mulnix.

Daniel was a farmer by trade but after his family had married and Sarah had passed away, he turned to Gold mining. His son Daniel Newton (Uncle Newt) was fatally injured in a fall down a mine in Leadville, Colo. in 1901. Daniel left Colorado to live with his daughter Emma and her family in Leanderville, Illinois. Daniel was kept busy helping with chores, making Maple

and keeping the Grandchildren happy. When Daniel would receive his Government Pension Check, Emma would load up and to town they would go. Grandfather would spend most of his check on candy for the children.

My father, Charles Skinner, Mother and I visited Jessie Husband Johnson and her family at the old Husband farm in Chester, Ill. in 1963. I saw Grandpa Daniel's room and his Maple trees.
