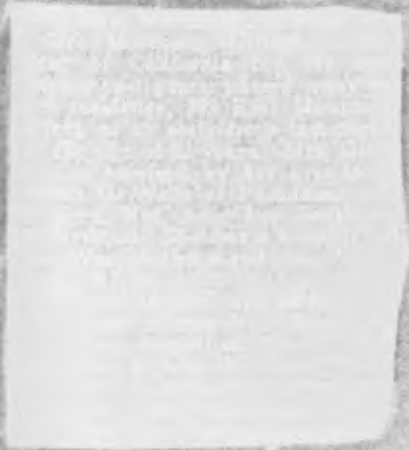

DEATH CLAIMS S. T. SKINNER, A PIONEER OF PIKE'S PEAK REGION

S. T. Skinner, a well-known real estate man of this city and a member of the firm of Little & Skinner, died at his home, 617 South Cascade avenue, yesterday afternoon at 2:23 o'clock of dropsy, after an illness of about six weeks. Funeral services will be held at the residence tomorrow afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, conducted by Rev. George Fink, of the Assembly of God. Interment will be in Evergreen cemetery.

Mr. Skinner was born in Indiana on April 24, 1848. In 1871 he crossed the plains in a wagon, reaching this region after a trying journey. He settled here, taking up government land. He was one of the organizers of the Boston Land company, which owned a large amount of land in the vicinity of Roswell, becoming manager of its affairs soon after its organization. Later Mr. Skinner became a member of the El Paso Auction com-

pany, of this city, and soon afterward engaged in the retail grocery business, which he followed until his connection with the Little & Skinner Realty company, of which he was a member at the time of his death. Mr. Skinner was one of the best-known men of the county, and his death has been a great shock to his friends. He leaves a widow and five children.

It is announced that no service will be held at the Assembly tomorrow afternoon on account of the funeral. Officers of the Assembly will serve as pallbearers.

Mrs. Malissa Melvina Skinner, 85, who was married here on April 5, 1874, with one of the first marriage licenses issued in El Paso county, died yesterday afternoon at her home, 831 High street. She had been a resident of Colorado Springs 60 years.

Born in Chicago March 16, 1848, she came to Colorado Springs in December, 1873. She was married the following spring to one of the region's first settlers.

Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock tomorrow afternoon from the Decker chapel with Rev. H. Guy Goodsell, pastor of the First M. E. church, officiating. Burial will be in Evergreen cemetery.

She is survived by two sons, Roy and Charles Skinner of Colorado Springs, and two brothers, L. Mulnix of Dodge City, Kan., and J. C. Mulnix of Woodland Park.
