Charles Wells Skinner was born in Roswell, Colorado in November, 1891, this is my Fathers life as he told it to me.

We moved from Roswell, to Colorado Springs in 1896, $\frac{1}{2}$ block South of the Court House on North east corner of the alley, on Tejon Street. I lived on South Nevada about 300 block, also at 703 S. Nevada Ave where South Junior High School now stands. (1898). We lived on West Costilla (3240 in 1900. West of the Rio Grande railroad tracks. Started school at the old Lincoln School then Lowell, Columbia and Senior High School.

In 1902 to 1906 worked at both Grocery Stores at Tejon and Rio Grande St. Also set pins at Antler Hotel Bowling Alley, before and after school, and summer vacation. In summer of 1907 worked at old Zoo on Cheyenne Road with cousin Clyde Dixon.

I quit school in February 1908 and went to work at Giddings and Kirkwood, now Fashion Bar on the corner. of Kiowa and Tejon. Then worked at Burgess Grocery in 1909 on North Tejon where Jewelry store now stands, about 100 North Tejon. In April, 10, went to work at Central Electric Co. 208 North Tejon, in 1913 the name changed to Whitney Electric Co. by Matt Whitney, later by sons Harold and Winston Whitney after his death.

In November 1917 enlisted in the Air Corp in World War I. Went to Kelly Field in San Antonio, Texas, A.M. College, at College Station, Texas. Carege Tech. Field, Waco, Texas. Discharged January 1919 at Rich Field, Waco, Texas. Went to work for Colorado Electric for about three weeks, then went back to work at Whitney Electric Company.

Retired in March 1959, on Wednesday, 52 years later in the same building as I started to work in. The May D. and F. store while wiring basement for Whitney Electric Co.

I was married to Myrtle May Clay, in the First Babtist Church by the Rev. Moore, in Denver, April 6, 1919, Easter Sunday. We lived at 2519 North Nevada Ave. when Dorothy was born, and at 309 North Hancock when Roy was born.

Built garage and then home at 1115 E. Boulder St. Moved to Black Forest 52 Shoup Road, after retiring.

My sports were boxing and motorcycle racing.

When very small and living in Roswell, I would tie myself to a tree and bray like a donkey, Grandpa Daniel Skinner would come out of the house and feed me a banana. I would get bananas as long as I brayed. When family lived south of town, Indians would look in the windows.

Skinner Wins in Colorado Hill Climb

OUT in the Pike's Peak region, where grades are steep and winding and difficult, the followers of the motorcycle have been forced to adapt themselves to the impediments of their mountainous roads. Hence, when the sacred circles of the faithful form at the headquarters of the various dealers in Colorado Springs, the discussion naturally revolves about "power" instead of "economy"—"gear ratios" in preference to "control types."

Now this essential quality, power, has long been a source of unsettled argument and keenest rivalry among Colorado adherents of the different makes of machines. Therefore, when a hill-climb was proposed recently as an official, final test of superior power, the plan was welcomed, and accorded hearty support by the Middle Western division of the "benzine bikers." Arrangements went forward with typical Western vim and enthusiasm. "Jones Hill," a steep gradient near Broadmoor, a suburb of Colorado Springs, was selected for the trials.

Sixteen of Colorado's finest speedsters were entered in the contest and tried their luck on the hill. One by one the

riders hurled their big twins up the grade—treating distance and gravity, and even Father Time, in a really shameless fashion.

Those of us who have tried, know that an altitude of fifty-three hundred feet ordinarily kills compression, and knocks about four of our seven pet horses in the head. Therefore, to make fast time on Jones Hill, finer adjustment, better motor condition, more accurate gear ratio, and more skillful driving were necessary.

After each of the riders had taken his allotted three trials, the results were found to be as follows: First, Charles Skinner, Indian, time 15½ seconds; second, Emmett Knight, Excelsior, 15 3-5 seconds; third, Vanderhof, Harley-Davidson, 16½ seconds. It is a significant fact that Skinner twice made the climb in the same winning time of 15½ seconds—proving that his victory was no stroke of luck, but an evidence of real speed and power.

Price, a crack rider of the Excelsior stronghold, was the victim of misfortune. On his first official ascent he took a bad fall, which while not injuring him seri-

ously, put him out of the running. He had been regarded as a strong contestant and his enforced withdrawal seriously crippled the Excelsior following.

Immediately after the regular program an elimination race was run off by the machines which had won the second and third prize. Vanderhof again rode the Harley, while George Flynn, a local dispenser of "speed dope," mounted the Excelsior. Flynn won, after one of the most spectacular ascents of the day.
