## SAMUEL P. YEOMANS 1840-1897

Samuel P. Yeomans was born in Thomas County, Georgia on Sept. 2, 1840, son of James Madison and Martha L. (Emanuel) Yeomans (Youmans). He was named after his grandfather, Samuel P. Yeomans (Youmans) who moved from Beaufort District, South Carolina to Tattnall County, Georgia in the 1810's. His parents moved to Shell Point District in Wakulla County, Florida about 1844. In the 1850's they settled in Franklin County, Florida near Appalachicola. The Youmans family homesteaded in Manatee County in south Florida in the early 1860's. Samuel P. Yeomans married Sarah Elizabeth Martin on September 25, 1864 at or near Manatee, Florida. She was born July 9, 1851. Children of Samuel P. and Sarah Elizabeth (Martin) Yeomans:
