In the mid 1840's, John Baggs Raulerson and other relatives settled in south Florida in Hillsborough County. John was a taxpayer in that county in 1847. John's homestead was east of present day Mt. Enon Church about three miles between there and Socrum on Mill Branch where he had a water mill.

John was a member of Capt. S. L. Sparkman's Independent Company of Florida Volunteers along with his brother, Noel Rabun Raulerson. He enlisted July 25, 1849 at Camp Gibson for six months and was honorably discharged at Camp Gibson on Oct. 23, 1849.

John's mother, Ellen, was living with him in 1850 in the Itchepucksassa settlement in Hillsborough County near

present day Plant City. The Raulersons were members of Salem Church in
