west of where the present Church now stands. Brother J. M. Hendry was called as the second pastor and was followed by A. J. Farabee in 1894. In 1895 Bro. J. M. Hendry was called to serve again until 1898 when Bro. J. M. Dotson became pastor. It was at this time, March 1896, that Sunday School was started with Mr. John Wright as the first Supt. In 1899 Bro. J. M. Hendry was called for the third time and remained for six years.

Sometime during the latter part of this period a transaction of the Church property was made (reserving the building) for a tract of land where our present Church is now located which was owned by Mr. Covington who was the owner of a large turpentine distillery and owned

a lot of land in this area.

In 1905, Rev. O. M. Williams became pastor and a new Church building was built under his leadership. In February 1906 a building committee was organized and consisted of Mr. J. W. Stewart, A. R. Rich and James Corbitt. On Aug. 3, 1906 those who volunteered to split shingles to cover the new Church were James Bryant, Elmon Corbitt, Ben Bryant, A. R. Rich, Tom Bryant and George Wingate. It was agreed that as much of the old building be used as possible. On March 17, 1907 a committee was appointed to have the deeds of the Church property recorded properly. This group was Sam Phillips, A. R. Rich and Jim Corbitt.

On Aug. 26, 1911 James Corbitt, A. R. Rich and W. A. Stewart were appointed to mark out a place for a cemetery on Bethany Church property. The Measuring Committee for the cemetery were A. R. Rich, Sam Phillips,

Langford, Mr. Clyde Hine and Mr. Ralph Wiley. Our other Church officers were: S. S. Supt, Mr. Robert Thompson, S. S. Secretary, Mrs. Ruby Rich, Church Clerk, Mrs. Linda Pope, Church Treasurer, Mr. Gary Rich.
