- Mathew COKER, Co. D; born in Madison County, Florida; enlisted at Cedar Keys Aug. 6, 1864, age 18; refugee from Confederacy; blue eyes, light hair, light complexion, 5'3".
- William Peyton COKER, Co. D; born in Irwin County, Georgia; enlisted at Taylor County, Florida, Apr. 10, 1864, age 20; refugee from Confederacy; blue eyes, light hair, fair complexion, 5'11"; died Aug. 5, 1864 at Cedar Keys from typhoid fever.
- John COLEMAN, Co. D; born in Wakulla County, Florida; enlisted at St. Vincent's Island, Florida, age 42; refugee from Confederacy; black eyes, brown hair, fair complexion, 6'.
- Calvin C. COLLIER, Co. B; born in Dooley County, Georgia; enlisted at Fort Myers, Florida on May 28, 1864, age 20; refugee from Confederacy; dark eyes, brown hair, light complexion, 5'8"; promoted to corporal, Mar. 1, 1865.
- John COLLIER, Co. B; born in Dooley County, Georgia; enlisted at Fort Myers, May 22, 1864, age 19; refugee from Confederacy; black eyes, light hair, light complexion, 5'5".
- George E. COLESON (COLSON), Co. C; born in Colleton District, South Carolina; enrolled Mar. 29, 1865 at Key West, age 41; died at Cedar Keys hospital, June 17, 1865 with measles.
- James T. COLVIN, Co. E; born in Gadsden County, Florida; enlisted at Cedar Keys, Dec. 20, 1864, age 26; refugee from Confederacy; black eyes, brown hair, light complexion, 5'8".
- Robert COLVIN, Co. E; born in Sparta County, Alabama; enlisted Dec. 20, 1864 at Cedar Keys, Florida, age 42; refugee from Confederacy; grey eyes, black hair, dark complexion, 5'7"; sick at Cedar Keys Jan. & Feb. 1865; died at post hospital from chronic diarrhea, Apr. 28, 1865.
- Major COODY (CODAY), Co. C; born in Hancock County, Georgia; enlisted June 20, 1864 at St. Vincent's Island, Fl., age 24; colored cook.
- Benjamin COOK, Co. E; born in Pike County, Alabama; enlisted Mar. 13, 1865 at Cedar Keys, age 18; blue eyes, light hair, light complexion, 5'5".
- William B. COONS, Co. B; born in Webb County, Virginia; enlisted June 13, 1864 at Fort Myers, Fl., age 20; refugee from Confederacy;
