

CORRECTIONS AND ADDITIONS

Issue #3, page 24

The S. T. HANCOCK shown on this page in the 1860 Hillsborough County census was incorrectly identified as Shadrach HANCOCK who married Sarah Jane KNIGHT. Shadrach was living in Manatee County at that time and is shown on the 1860 Manatee County census (see Issue #1, page 31). The S. T. HANCOCK in 1860 Hillsborough County was apparently the same person as Stephen T. HANCOCK shown on the 1861 tax list for Polk County (see Issue #6, page 9).

Issue #12, page 8

Dempsey D. Crews' wife, Piety (COLLIER) CREWS was the daughter of Henry COLLIER, not John COLLIER, SR. Henry COLLIER died in 1840 in Dooly County, Georgia and his estate proceedings list "Piety CRUISE" and her husband "Dempsey CRUISE" as heirs. See also SOUTH FLORIDA PIONEERS, Issue #15/16, page 22.

Issue #11, page 18

Solomon GODWIN was a son of Solomon GODWIN, SR., and Mary (REID) GODWIN. Mary Ann (STARLING) HINSON, second wife of Solomon, the subject of the sketch, was first married to Eddie HINSON. Her father's first name was either John or Levi. Sources differ on this. Issue #15/16, page 41

Uriah Raiford DURRANCE was a son of David Jasper (or Jackson) and Mary (DOUGLAS) DURRANCE. They were married in Tattnall Co., Ga., March 23, 1837. David J. was a son of Jesse and Rebecca (DELOACH) DURRANCE.

Issue #21/22, page 50

James M. HENDRY's second wife, Martha Frances WINGATE was the daughter of John Hiram and Rebecca Porter (JOHNSON) WINGATE. "Porter" was Mrs. WINGATE's middle name not her maiden name as shown.

Issue #23/24, page 10

The LOCKLEARs did not move to Lafayette County, Florida prior to 1860. Lafayette County was carved out from Madison County in 1856, so that they were probably living in the same general area in the 1850 Madison Co. census and 1860 Lafayette County census.
