

(seventy years) -- prevents him permanently from gaining livelihood." SOLDIERS OF FLORIDA show that "Mayfield" McClelland was mustered in to Company E of the 7th Florida Infantry, CSA on April 10, 1862 and that he was a corporal in this unit. Maxfield was awarded a pension of \$120 per year on certificate #6952.

A tragic thing happened on May 5, 1909, as a fire destroyed his home, all household goods including his federal pension certificate.

Maxfield McClelland died September 6, 1909. It is believed that his wife had died earlier since she did not apply for a widow's pension. He is buried in Friendship Cemetery in Hardee County south of Zolfo Springs. His grave is unmarked.
