## WILLIAM JACKSON JOHNSON 1857-1907

William Jackson Johnson was born in Columbia County, Florida on May 16, 1857 son of Elias E. and Elizabeth (Keen) Johnson. He grew up near Lake City and moved to south Florida with his parents in 1866 settling near Fort Ogden in Manatee (present day DeSoto) County.

In the mid-1870's the Johnson family moved to Polk County homesteading near Bereah. On January 4, 1877 William Jackson Johnson married Mary Ann Douglas. She was born August 4, 1858 in Clinch County, Georgia daughter of John and Rachel (Stephens) Douglas. Her family had also settled in Polk County in the mid-1870's.
