In 1886 Tempy Chancey paid taxes on the same land as in 1884, one horse, 125 cattle and 50 hogs. On July 13, 1894 she applied for a widow's pension. She said that at the time of her husband's enlistment he was 22 years old, 5'll" with blue eyes, brown hair and light complexion.

Tempie was included in the Dry Prairie district in the 1900 census. Susan Chancey, age 26, was living with her. Living near by were Mary A. Levins & three of her children, Rebecca

Wingate, Samuel Keen and Nickey B. Keen.

Tempy died Oct. 28, 1904 and was receiving \$8 per month pension at the time. She was buried in the Chancey Cemetery.
