

and no person is bound for her support. Her income from all sources as spring 1894 was 80 dollars and 16 cents.

Her claim was approved under certificate no. 468877, commencing August 16, 1890 at \$8 per month. Eliza Green died on August 8, 1903 at Pine Level.
