

MRS. ARMUTH FUNERAL SERVICES HELD MONDAY

The death of Mrs. Herman Armuth, occurred Saturday morning at 9:30 following a long illness from cancer. She had been confined to her bed for many weeks.

Funeral services were held Monday morning at nine o'clock from St. Mary's Catholic church, Rev. Jas. P. Fullam, the pastor, celebrating a solemn requiem-high mass, Rev. Anton Link assisting as deacon and Rev. Anthony Egging as sub-deacon. Burial was made in Sidney beside her first husband.

Minnie Strotman was born October 19, 1870, in Cincinnati, Ohio, and at death was aged 70 years, 5 months and 14 days. She came with her parents to Columbus, Neb., in 1878 and later moved to Petersburg, Neb., where she was united in marriage with Fred Seger on April 13, 1891. On March 15, 1907, the family moved to Sidney, Neb., where Mr. Seger died in 1922. On February 25, 1925, she became the wife of Herman Armuth and since that time had lived in Dalton.

Mrs. Armuth is survived by her husband and one daughter, Mrs. Mary White of Berkeley, California, who had been at the bedside of her mother for several weeks.
