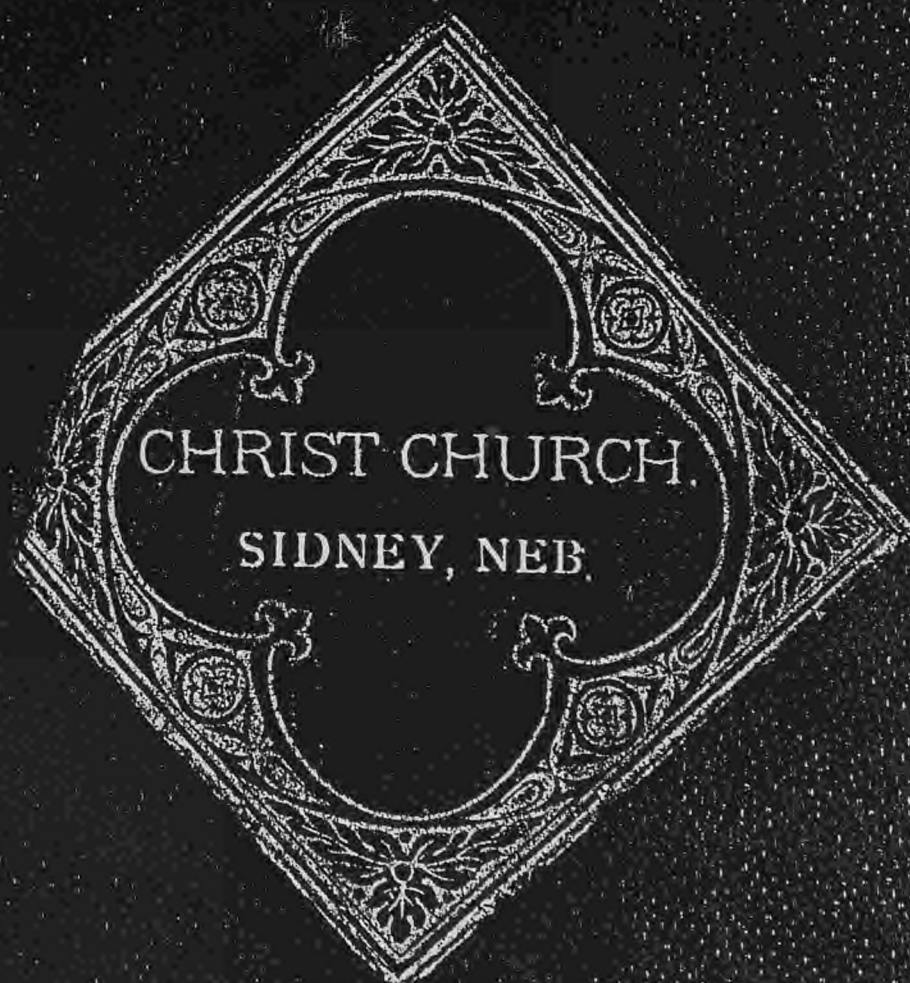

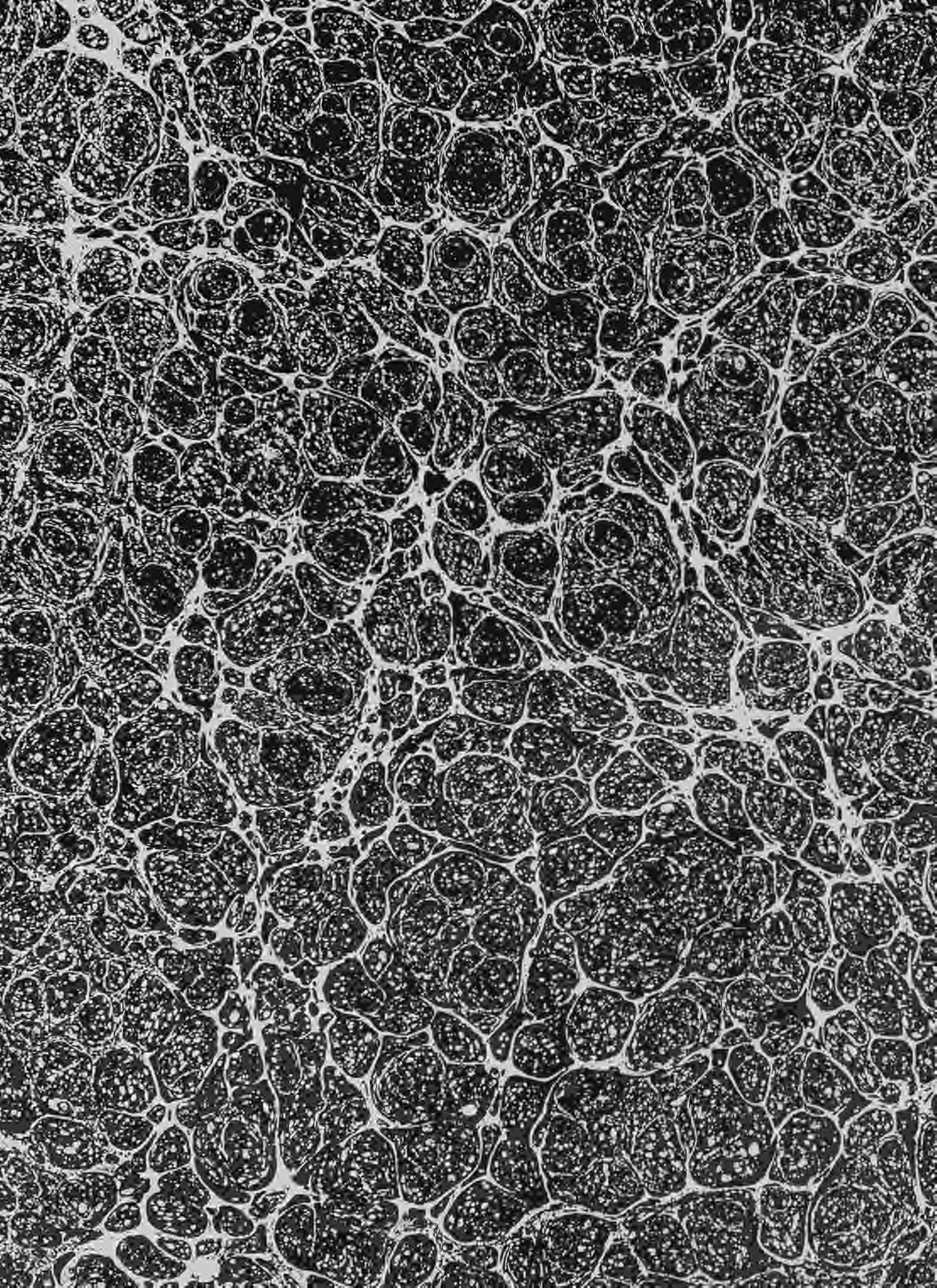

## HOW TO KEEP PARISH RECORDS.

---

Every Parish and Mission should keep three books or sets of books. The CHURCH REGISTER is kept by the Rector; the MINUTE BOOK by the Clerk of the Vestry; the ACCOUNT BOOK by the Treasurer. All three are to be open to all proper parties at all times.

The CHURCH REGISTER contains the vital records of the Parish, and is legal evidence as to births, marriages and burials. It is to be examined by the Bishop at his annual visitation. The records should be entered immediately upon performance of any office, by the minister himself. Where practicable, the Marriage Record should be signed by at least two witnesses, as well as by the officiating minister.

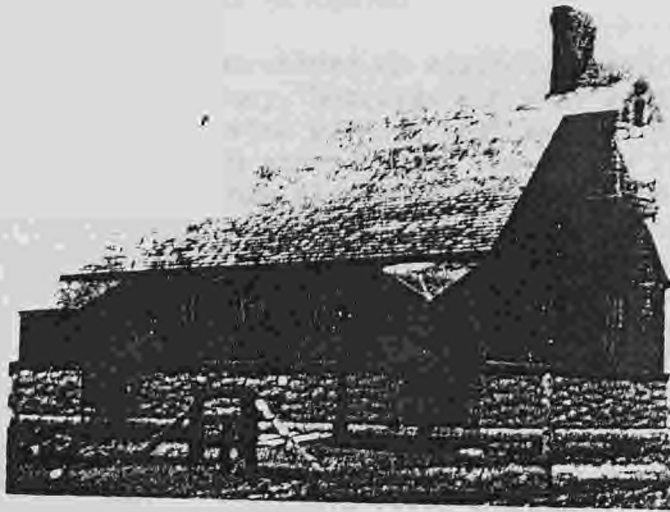
All permanent entries should be recorded in black ink. Temporary Memoranda as to Communicants and Families as "can't find" "ceased to communicate," etc. should be made in pencil as easy to erase and not proper as permanent record. No name should ever be erased or scratched. Every name, once entered, must be accounted for in the Register. Where communicants are transferred to another Parish, enter "transferred to A.B.," with date. If Letter of Transfer is not issued, enter "removed," etc.

A new name entered on any page should also be entered in the Index. The Index should refer to each page upon which any name is entered for any purpose.

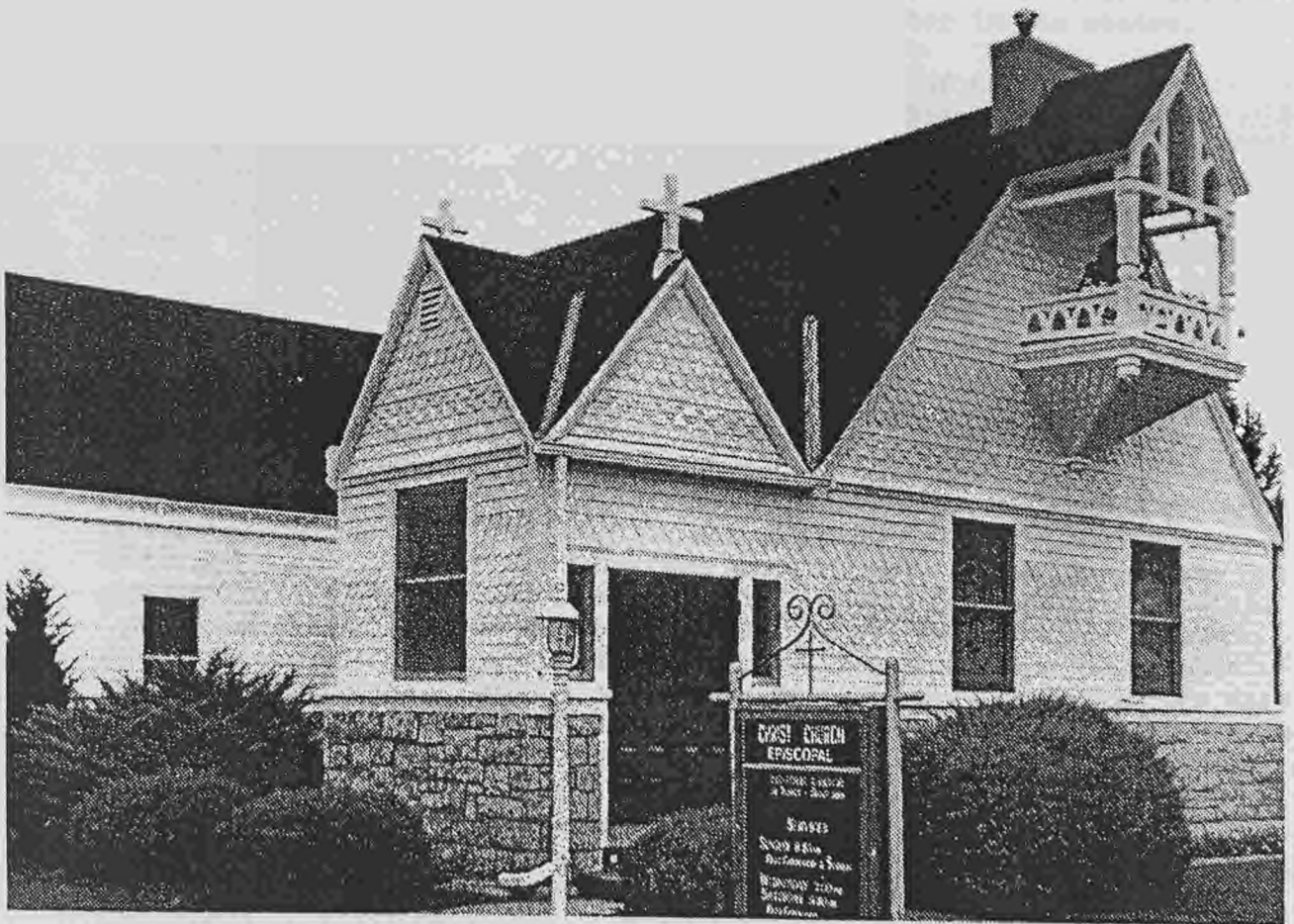
The List of Families entered in the Appendix is also required by canon, though not properly a part of the Parish Register. It is bound together with the smaller Registers in order to save the expense and trouble of keeping two books.

Suitable blanks and certificates for Marriage, Letters of Transfer, Application for Baptism and other offices, Blanks for Family Record, etc., may be obtained from the publishers of this Register.

## IN THE BEGINNING

Those who worship, have worshiped or visited within these walls of Christ Episcopal Church in Sidney, Nebraska are ever reminded of the countless manifestations of Divine purpose that members of the Church have given to glorify the human experience. The little frontier church, built with love, to serve God now stands as testimony and heir to its founders of Christian Anglican faith who have weathered the prejudices of sect and arose victorious here in America's Republic. This church on a crossroad of the nation in its pioneer days has witnessed and been proxy to the spiritual needs of men, women and children from several nations, creeds, races as well as both civilian and military personnel as confirmed by its records.

Between 1879 and 1903, 197 adults and children were baptised, 128 confirmed into the faith, 35 blessed in their marriage vows and 57 buried under its direction. Between 1903 and 1945, 267 were baptised, 194 confirmed, 96 married and 94 buried.

Those are the facts. Christ Episcopal Church has an aura that the life-giving sunshine of the western high plains which shines through its beautiful stained-glass memorial windows lends it and reminds worshipers of the Episcopalianism in America that culminated in missions and later dioceses, first in the nation's territories and later in its states.

Following is a brief summary of the history of the "Anglican Missionary Movement" that was responsible for the Sidney, Nebraska Episcopal Church:

In the beginning the Protestant Episcopal Church was weak in the United States at the close of the Revolutionary War--only a handful of members in comparison to the Pilgrims. It was a "piece of heavy baggage which the British had left behind when they evacuated New York and Boston." (p. 6) However, a manifestation of divine purpose seems to have intervened for Episcopalianism in the new land quickly rallied forces, closed their ranks and elected a bishop, SAMUEL SEABURY, who was ordained in Scotland by Scottish bishops following the War.

The next two Episcopal bishops to serve in the United States were consecrated in England. (The Mother Church by that time had withdrawn its opposition to the "new" Anglican Daughter as she grew in America-- it seemed apparent that the Daughter was disposed to follow English doctrine and discipline and was therefore accepted into the fold.) Consequently, by 1787 there were three Episcopal bishops in the United States.

By that time the demography along the eastern seaboard and in the southland was not pushing too many members of the Episcopal Church onto the western frontier. Those who did move westward were basically the discontented classes who took their affiliations with them. Episcopalianism as a whole were not an active mission force because most were socially prominent and well off. They felt secure in the status quo.

Never the less by 1793 General Convention decreed that an annual sermon and an offering be made for missions. In 1814 the Diocese of Pennsylvania a SOCIETY FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF CHRISTIANITY was formed to involve the Church in missionary work. By 1821 a Domestic and Foreign Missionary Society had been formed as a result of a gift in support of missions; the objective of creating missions on the western frontier among them.



## IN THE BEGINNING (continued)

By 1835 there were 1.5 million Episcopalians in the United States, but their offerings for mission work left much to be desired--about one cent a year. A campaign to raise money began and a bishop, Bishop PHILANDER CHASE was selected as missionary bishop for organization of churches on the Western Frontier. But after this step the problem of continuing support arose. Up until this time the Episcopal Church in America had been a federation of self governing state churches. In 1835 "Episcopacy passed from the idea of a Federation of State Churches to that of a National Church with component dioceses." (S. D. McConnell, History of the American Episcopal Church, Milwaukee, 1916, p. 310.) Under the new arrangement missionary bishops and the churches they founded could be supported until conditions warranted the organizations of dioceses.

The same year two frontier missionary bishops were chosen, but one declined his election leaving the other, JACKSON KEMPER, to cover the vast region now known as Indiana, Missouri, Wisconsin and Iowa and later expanded to include Kansas, NEBRASKA and Minnesota.

In 1860 BISHOP JOSEPH C. TALBOT of Nebraska and Wyoming fame succeeded Bishop Kemper with an even greater territory to supervise; the western border had been expanded to the Pacific Coast. Bishop Talbot called himself "the Bishop-of-All-Out-of-Doors."

Even in the light of modern transportation such a vast distance would be overwhelming for one man to adequately cover and supervise church foundations. So after months of bouncing stagecoaches, Army ambulances guarded by frontier soldiers through land still held by hostile Indians or astride unfamiliar horses that he was often left to groom and care for, in horse-drawn buggies and wagons under summer's scorching sun and winter's blizzards and freezing cold, helping with chores, cooking and sleeping in tents, the good Bishop finally protested.

In 1865 some of the responsibility was assumed by two additional bishops: BISHOP ROBERT H. CLARKSON, appointed to cover NEBRASKA and the Dakota Territory and Bishop George M. Randall, Colorado.

During the years between 1865 and 1907 more bishops were elected to missionary work on the western frontier and districts changed. In 1898 the ecclesiastical jurisdiction of Wyoming was divided into three parts: one included Eastern Wyoming and Western NEBRASKA known as the MISSIONARY DISTRICT OF LARAMIE. Christ Episcopal Church, Sidney, Nebraska, was in this district. The RIGHT REVEREND or BISHOP ANSON ROGER GRAVES was elected to preside.

Of interest to those who read this sketch is a remark made by BISHOP GARRETT who was assigned to the Panhandle of Texas in those early "missionary" days that very well summarizes the task and dedication of those Episcopal-Frontier-Church-Founders: "O, for a man who can ride like a cowboy, pray like a saint, preach like an apostle, and having food and raiment be therewith content." (Spirit of Missions, XLIV 1884, p. 562)

## CHRIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH OF SIDNEY

One of the outstanding landmarks of Cheyenne County is Christ Episcopal Church of Sidney. The story of Christ Church is closely linked to the development of the American frontier. The history of the church begins with the first attachment of soldiers that were sent to Fort Sidney to protect travelers and workers on the Union Pacific Railroad. When a permanent garrison was stationed at Fort Sidney, Christ Church became the official chapel for the fort. Officers and their families, English cowboys, itinerant workers on the railroad, Indian soldiers converted to the Christian faith, ranchers and townspeople all depended on Christ Church for the nurturing of their Christian beliefs.

Even before there was a church building, the Episcopal church sent missionaries to the frontier of Western Nebraska. When Fort Sidney was established as a permanent garrison, the officers sent for their families. The families living at the Fort felt the lack of Christian services in the new territory. Caroline Frey Winne, wife of Lt. Charles Winne, wrote to her brother. This is an excerpt from her letter: "What do you think? We have been to church this morning for the first time in two years! An Episcopal clergyman from Omaha (Frank R. Millspaugh, Dean of Trinity Church) held services in the schoolhouse. I was astonished to see such a good congregation. He seemed to be a very earnest good man and gave us a good plain earnest talk from the text..... There is no place on the face of the earth where preaching and true missionary work are needed more than here."

The Episcopal church continued to send missionary workers to Sidney. On March 11, 1877, the Reverend Gerhard of North Platte instituted Episcopal services in Sidney every second week. For two years, services were held in the Masonic Lodge. Then, in 1879, The Reverend William Page Case was assigned as the permanent Episcopal priest for the Missionary District of Western Nebraska. He established a parish in Sidney. On May 7, 1880, Bishop Clarkson confirmed seven persons and buried the infant child of Mr. and Mrs. Fred Clary.

The first real efforts to provide a church building came when Father John Babcock took over the parish on May 25, 1886. He could see that the parishioners needed their own building. Through his efforts, land was acquired and enough money collected to construct the building. Plans were drawn up by Mr. F. M. Ellis, an architect from Omaha. The stone work was assigned to Thomas Walsh. Christ Church was established at Tenth and Linden.

On November 23, 1886, the cornerstone was laid. The ~~9th~~<sup>Ninth</sup> Infantry band led a procession from downtown to the site of the church. Members of the Masonic fraternity laid the cornerstone. Parishioners placed mementoes and artifacts in the cornerstone and it was sealed.

After the church was consecrated by Bishop George Worthington, on July 28, 1889, it became the official chapel for Fort Sidney. The vicar was Chaplain Thomas Berry. The Vestry president was Captain Ebenezer Stone. Lt. Cornman supervised the Sunday School. Most of the men in Company I were Sioux Indians who had been confirmed by Bishop Hare. Soldiers, Indians, townspeople, cowboys and ranchers filled the small church to capacity.

In 1892, Reverend George Allen Beecher and his wife Florence came to Christ Church. They not only served the Sidney parish, but they also traveled to Gering, Bayard, Bridgeport, Minatare, Harrisburg, Kimball, and outlying ranches to hold services. When he became a bishop, Reverend Beecher published a book called A Bishop of the Great Plains. In it he gives a humorous account of his travels as a missionary priest in Western Nebraska.

While he was in Sidney, Reverend Beecher delivered his sermons in both English and Lakota, the language of the Sioux Indians. He taught the Indians how to speak, read and write in English. Many of the Indians from Company I served in the church. Yellowbird played the organ. Private Knee was the catechist and interpreter. Many of the Indian soldiers sang in the choir. A grandson of Crookedfoot still lives in Sidney.

Eventually the garrison at Fort Sidney was no longer necessary. The fort was abandoned and the soldiers and their families moved on to new duty assignments. Christ Church continued in its service to the community.

Through the years the early heritage of Christ Church has been preserved. One of the stained glass windows contains the Seal of the Missionary District of Western Nebraska. Another window depicts the prairie and life on the ranches. Still another reflects the Indian heritage of Christ Church. Sea, sky, and earth tones are background for the Cross of gold. These are only a few of the beautiful stained glass windows donated through the years. The candlesticks, altar cross, and vases have been in use since the early 1900's. The chalice and the paten now on display at Christ Church had been in continual use

until 1962. Legend has it that this chalice and paten were made of silver dollars donated by the men of Company I when they were falsely accused of having stolen the original chalice and paten. The men themselves made the chalice and the paten. They paid to have this inscription put on the chalice:

Uicobe I, 21"Infantry

Christ Tipi - Wakan Kin

Sidney Otoune, Nebraska

ed miniyaka Wakan Kin de yuju

Wakunapi Owasin Tuanpetupi Kin

1893

(Troop I, 21st Infantry to Christ Church, Sidney, Nebraska.

This Holy Chalice was given on All Saints Day 1893)

The bell which summons parishioners to worship each Sunday, was once used in an old Spanish mission in Questa, New Mexico. It was donated by Dr. Hull Cook.

Christ Episcopal Church still stands as a symbol of bygone glory and hardship on the early western frontier. After more than 100 years the parish still holds regular services in this building. Christ Episcopal Church plays an important part in the history and folklore of Cheyenne County and the city of Sidney.

## Downtown district, Episcopal Church make National Register

Christ Episcopal Church and the Sidney Historic Business District were officially listed in the National Register of Historic Places, Bob Puschendorf, deputy state historic preservation officer at the Nebraska State Historical Society, announced.

"We are especially pleased to make this announcement considering the number of buildings in the Sidney Historic District and the historically significant Episcopal Church in the same community," Puschendorf said.

Christ Episcopal Church, at 10th and Linden, is a one-story frame stone building originally constructed in 1866-67. Despite later additions, the church retains its historical integrity.

The original church was a cross-shaped building built in the single-style, a style which did not become popular until the late 1870's. The base of the building is made from locally quarried limestone and capped by a wood water-table. The remainder of the church is wood frame construction featuring lap siding with patterns of decorative shingles.

In 1866, Congress passed the Army Bill, which among other things called for the establishment of four regiments composed of African-American enlisted personnel. Due in part to the success of the program, Secretary of War Redfield Proctor supported the idea of enlisting Native American as regular soldiers.

On Sept. 1, 1891, 2nd Lt. Samuel Seay, Jr., was assigned to recruit and command Native American Company 1, headquartered at Fort Sidney. Along with regular garrison duties, the Native American soldiers attended school to learn to read and write.

Many of the Indian soldiers became members of Christ Episcopal Church. The church was one of the parishes in Rev. George Beecher's mission field. Beecher gave sermons in both English and Lakota, the language of the Native American soldiers. Of the men in the company active in the church, one served as an organist, another a catechist and interpreter, while others sang in the choir.

For a variety of reasons, this social

experiment by the army did not achieve the expected results. Many of the men were not satisfied with army life and, in particular, Fort Sidney. On May 19, 1893, 19 members of the company petitioned for their discharge, saying they wanted to return to their homes and look after their families and farms.

Christ Episcopal Church is one of a few remaining physical representations in the state closely associated with the government's attempt to integrate Native Americans into the Army.

The Sidney Historic Business District is located in a five-block area near the Union Pacific Railroad in the historic center of the original town of Sidney. Comprised primarily of early 20th century commercial buildings, the district includes evidence of the first enclave of buildings constructed in the late 19th century.

The district consists of a virtually uninterrupted streetscape of commercial buildings on both sides of the five-block area. Thirty-two buildings are

located in the district and reflect simplified applications of Late Victorian and Neoclassical Revival style architecture. The exclusive use of brick and limestone masonry construction is a distinctive feature of the district. Alterations to first-floor storefronts have occurred through time, although the district still retains its historical character with 29 contributing and three non-contributing buildings.

An important characteristic of the district is the exclusive use of masonry materials; all of the contributing buildings are constructed of limestone or brick. In some cases, locally quarried limestone blocks were used for structural load-bearing walls.

Another distinctive feature of the district is a consistent use of two-part facades. Twenty-six of the 29 contributing buildings use the two-part facade design. The first-floor store fronts with central recessed entries and large display windows are separate in character from the office and apartment rooms located on the second

floors. Most of the 29 buildings were constructed between 1916 and 1920.

The Sidney Historic Business District's collection of late 19th and early 20th Century buildings conveys a strong association with a historic period of economic prosperity unrivaled in the western Nebraska panhandle. This prosperity was caused by a combination of historical events unique to the region during the late 19th century.

The National Register of Historical Places is America's list of significant archeological, historical and cultural places. In Nebraska, the program is administered by the State Historical Preservation Office at the Nebraska State Historical Society.

The inclusions bring to 10 the number of Cheyenne County sites listed in the National Register. Others include the Lodgepole Opera House, The Brownson Viaduct, Herboldsheimer Stone Ranch buildings, Leeper rings, Sidney-Deadwood Draw, Fort Sidney Museum, old Sidney Carnegie Library and the Waterhole Ranch.

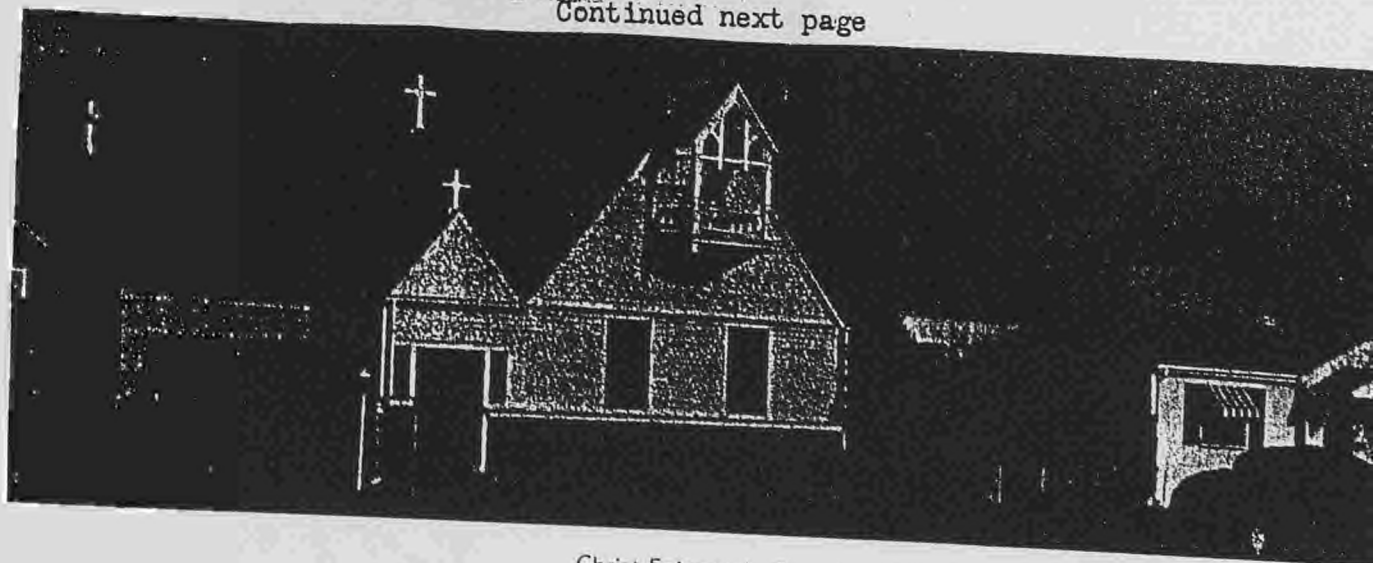
## PREFACE

The purpose of the following set of records transcribed from the second canonical record ledger of historic Christ Episcopal Church, Sidney, Cheyenne County, Nebraska, is first to preserve the official records of the church, and next to serve as a resource for those genealogists who are seeking official documentation to their research or as verification of names and facts for those who are looking for family ties.

The records have been transcribed to duplicate the originals as nearly as was possible for often the handwriting was all but impossible to decipher. For this reason spellings will vary from year to year and record to record since they were recorded by numerous parishioners, witnesses and rectors over the years. When a signature was absolutely undecipherable, the word "illegible" has been placed in brackets to indicate the fact. Three names were inadvertently omitted on index pages 66 and 67. They are marked by asterisks and placed at the bottom of those pages.

The CANONICAL CHURCH REGISTER is a 16 by 11 size ledger providing entries a two page spread. Since placing so much information on a standard 8 1/2 by 11 inch sheet of paper and allowing space for binding would make the print too small to read, entries in the BAPTISM, CONFIRMATION, MARRIAGE AND BURIAL sections have been placed upon two pages, marked PART A and PART B. with prefix numbers on each entry to show the relationships. For example: to find all the information on the baptism of Mary Jane Jones, look in THE TABLE OF CONTENTS under BAPTISM Part A. to find number 16 on page 14. Information under Part A, number 16, page 14 includes the name of the candidate being baptised, sex, date of birth, place and date of baptism. To find the rest of the entry about the baptism of Mary Jane Jones, turn to page 20. There the rest of the recorded information about the baptism of Mary Jane Jones (names of parents, names of witnesses to the baptism and the officiating rector or minister) is recorded under the same prefix number--16.

The RECTOR section in the original ledger was filled in only by the Reverend Richard Whitehouse. Following names of church rectors, bishops, official assistants and dates of service were taken from dates recorded as each church official administered his service at a confirmation, baptism, wedding or burial.

No complete index of all names recorded in the ledger was kept. To assist those using this transcription, indexes of each section are provided with page numbers of each index listed in the TABLE OF CONTENTS.

In summary, a final word of explanation about the original records: the reason for the several "revised" lists of communicants is the fact that several lists were copied from a church ledger kept previous to the one herein transcribed.

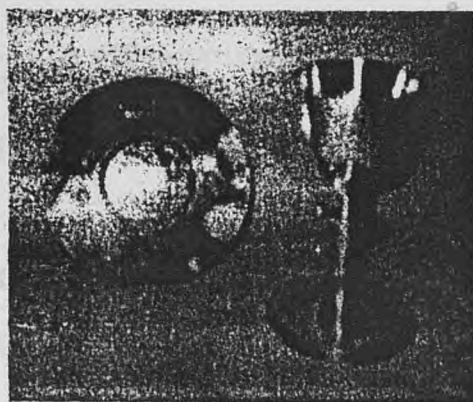
