Know all men by these presents that I Peterson Old of Nottoway County for and in consideration of the sum of ninety pounds current money of Virginia to me in hand paid by William Grigg of the said County the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have and by these presents do grant bargain sell and confirm unto the said William Grigg his heirs executors or administrators or assigns forever one certain negro woman known by the name of Dilcey and her future increase to the said William Grigg to have and to hold the aforesaid negro Dilcey and her further increase free from the claim of all and every body forever and the said Peterson Old for himself his heirs executors and administrators doth hereby covenant and agree with the said William Grigg his heirs executors administrators or assigns, that he the said Peterson Old will warrant and forever defend a good and lawful title in and to the said negro Dilce and her future increas against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever In witness whereof the said Peterson Old hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal this tenth day of October eighteen hundred and one. Signed, sealed and delivered in presence of Peterson Old (Seal) John Vaughan Josiah Grigg Sarah Cabaniss
