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This Indenture made this fourth day of January Eighteen hundred & four between Peter Grigg and Elizabeth Grigg his wife of the County of Nottoway of the one part and Peter Branch Jones of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Peter Grigg and Elizabeth Grigg for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy one pounds six shillings and six pence current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Peter Branch Jones the receipt of which they do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents to grant bargain and sell alien Enfeoff and confirm unto him the said Peter B. Jones one certain tract or parcel of land in the County of Nottoway containing seventy nine and a quarter acres be the same more or less and bounded as followeth (to wit) on the north by the lands of Peter B. Jones and Robert Jones on the east by the waters of Robert Jones's mill and on the South and west by the lands of Joe Grigg it being the said tract of land whereon we the said Peter Grigg and Elizabeth Grigg now lives, with all and singular the appertinances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining and the said Peter Grigg and Elizabeth his wife do covenant and agree to and with the said Peter B. Jones to warrant and defend the title of the said land to him the said Peter B. Jones his heirs and assigns forever, free from any claim of themselves their heirs Exors^s or assigns or from the claim or claims of any other person whatsoever In Witness whereof we the said Peter Grigg and Elizabeth Grigg have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals the day and year first within written.
