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This Indenture made and entered into this twenty fifth day of May in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and thirteen between Josiah Grigg of the county of Nottoway of the one part and William Grigg of the said county of the other part Witnesseth that the said Josiah Grigg for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred dollars current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said William Grigg, at and before the Sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he the said Josiah Grigg doth hereby acknowledge and forever acquit and discharge the said William Grigg from the payment thereof, hath granted, bargained and sold, aliened, enfeoffed, and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell, alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said William Grigg and his heirs forever, One certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the county of Nottoway containing by estimation One hundred and forty nine and three quarters acres, be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Peter B. Jones on the North, and the lands of William Grigg and John Epes on the South, and by Jones' Mill pond on the East and Woody Creek on the West, also the following ten negroes, to wit, Charles, Burrel, Sam, Dick, Anderson, Fanny, Lucy, Jenny, Hannah and Grace with their increase, also five horses, to wit, one bay mare, one black mare, one sorrel horse, one black colt, and one bay colt, also all my Stock of Cattle, amounting to twenty head, and Stock of Sheep amounting to twenty five head and also all my household and kitchen furniture and plantation utensels, To have and to hold the said Tract or parcel of land and the said negroes, horses, cattle, sheep and hogs and the said household & Kitchen furniture and plantation utensels by these presents bargained and sold to him the William Grigg and his heirs forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said William Grigg and his heirs forever And the said Josiah Grigg for himself his heirs executors and administrators doth covenant contract and agree to and with the said William Grigg and his heirs that the right and title in and to the said Tract or parcels of land and the said negroes, horses, cattle sheep and hogs, and household and Kitchen furniture and plantation utensels to him the said William Grigg and his heirs forever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents, against the claim or claims of all or any other person or persons whatsoever.
